

RETURN

OF

MAORIS KILLED OR WOUNDED AT OPOTIKI.

(Return to an Order of the House of Representatives, dated 27th September, 1865.)

That there be laid on the Table of this House—“A Return showing the number and names (if the latter can be supplied) of the Maoris that have been killed or wounded by the Colonial Forces within ten days from their arrival at Opotiki; the names of the Civil Commissioner or Magistrates who accompanied the expedition; also, a copy of the Proclamation or demand made for the surrender of the murderers of the Rev. Mr. Volkner and others.”
