*Return to an Order of the House of Representatives, dated the 8th day of June, 1869.*

That there be laid upon the Table of this House—"A Return showing the number of Europeans that have been killed and wounded, distinguishing those engaged in actual warfare from those who were not. Also,—A Return of the friendly Natives killed and wounded, and the actually ascertained number of the Enemy killed or captured, showing the places at which such occurrences took place. Return to be from the 1st of May, 1868, up to the present date."
