OFFICERS PERMITTED TO RECEIVE REMUNERATION FOR SERVICES OUTSIDE THEIR SERVICE TO GENERAL GOVERNMENT.

Return to an Order of the House of Representatives of the 20th day of July, 1876.

“That there be laid before this House a return showing what salaried officers of the General Government, receiving salaries in excess of £200 a year, are permitted to receive remuneration for services outside of their service to the General Government.”—(Mr. Murray.)

John Knowles ...	Under Secretary for Public Works	Is permitted to act as one of the Auditors of the Wellington Trust and Loan Company.
John Carruthers ...	Engineer-in-Chief	By the terms of his engagement, permitted to undertake such private work as the Hon. the Minister for Public Works may consent to, and provided it does not interfere with his official duties.
John Blackett ...	Assistant Engineer-in-Chief	} These officers have, at the request of provincial and municipal authorities, been permitted to give their advice on provincial and municipal matters.

William N. Blair...	District Engineer, Dunedin ...	
Arthur D. Dobson	Resident Engineer, Westport ...	By terms of his engagement, permitted to act as Consulting Engineer, provided his doing so does not interfere with his official duties.
W. H. Clayton ...	Colonial Architect	Is permitted to prepare plans, &c., for a local branch line of railway.
John Marshman ...	Commissioner of Crown Lands, Christchurch	By terms of his engagement, permitted to take private business, provided his doing so does not interfere with his official duties.
Cyrus Goulter ...	Commissioner of Crown Lands, Blenheim	Is one of the local trustees of the Trust and Agency Company of Australia (Limited). Average receipts from this source for the last seven years, £15 15s. a year.
C. D. Whitcombe	Commissioner of Crown Lands, New Plymouth	Receives a salary of £160 per annum as Provincial Secretary.
W. H. Pearson ...	Commissioner of Crown Lands, Invercargill	Receives a salary of £50 per annum as a member of the Waste Lands Board.
G. W. Williams ...	District Surveyor, Confiscated Lands Department, Patea	Receives a salary of £100 per annum as District Land Officer, under the 14th clause of “The Otago Waste Lands Act, 1872.”
R. Johnson ...	Inspector of Steamers and Nautical Assessor	Acts as Engineer (temporarily) to Town Board, Carlyle, and Road Board, Patea District, but has not yet received any remuneration.
		Receives a salary of £25 a year for acting as Marine Surveyor to the New Zealand Insurance Company.
