N.B.—The Medicines, &c., must be procured from the Apothecaries' Hall, or from some duly qualified Chemists and Druggists, and be approved by the Agent-General. All the Medicines to be put in Stopper Bottles, and the Ointments in Tins. All the poisonous articles to be legibly marked "Poisons." Where more than 16 oz. of an article are required it is to be supplied in two vessels—one for use, and the other for store:—
