TELEGRAPH STATIONS

(RETURNS RELATIVE TO, FOR SEVEN YEARS ENDED JUNE 30, 1878).

Return to an Order of the House of Representatives, dated 25th September, 1878.

“Return showing what Telegraph Stations established in the colony have failed in any year or years to cover their expenses by their business, specifying whether established under local guarantee, and if so, whether such guarantee has been enforced.”—(*Hon. Mr. Fox.*)

RETURN showing the Receipts and Expenditure of the various Telegraph Stations throughout the Colony, embracing those Stations which have failed in any year or years to cover their expenses by their business, and showing, also, Guaranteed Stations and Amounts recovered under Guarantee, for the seven years ended the 30th June, 1872-1878.
