Of the candidates who failed, 1 failed in 7 subjects, 1 failed in 6 subjects, 2 failed in 5 subjects, 4 failed in 4 subjects, 5 failed in 3 subjects, 6 failed in 2 subjects, 4 failed in 1 subject; 36 examined and 18 failed in English, 30 examined and 5 failed in Latin, 36 examined and 5 failed in arithmetic, 36 examined and 8 failed in geography, 14 examined and 4 failed in trigonometry, 33 examined and 11 failed in algebra, 33 examined and 10 failed in geometry, 4 examined and 2 failed in physical science, 31 examined and 9 failed in history
