ACTUAL SERVICE.

19. In case of actual or apprehended invasion of any part of New Zealand, or other emergency proclaimed by the Governor, Volunteer corps may be assembled for actual military service, and, whenever they are so assembled, they will be liable to serve in any part of New Zealand.

PRECEDENCE.

20. The Volunteer Force is composed of the following arms, ranking in order as under:—

FIRST LINE.
Cavalry Volunteers.

SECOND LINE.
Naval Volunteers.

21. Relative precedence of companies will be determined by the dates of formation.

22. Officers of the Volunteer Force rank as juniors of their respective ranks with officers in the regular Forces of Her Majesty, and as seniors of their respective ranks with officers of any Militia raised in the colony, except when the Militia is called out for actual service; but all field officers of Her Majesty's regular Forces will command all field officers of the Volunteer Force. This rule not to have retrospective effect,
