I have the honour to furnish an interim return of sheep. The total number in the colony on the 31st May, 1888, as compiled from the returns, was 15,010,825; and in addition to this it is estimated there will be about \$0,000 more to include, for which returns have not yet been received, making in all 15,040,825, as against 15,155,626 for 1887, or a deficiency of 114,801.

throughout the colony.
