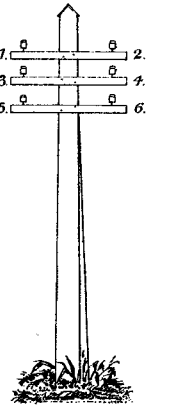


NORTH ISLAND N. Z. TELEGRAPH AND TELEPHONE CIRCUITS

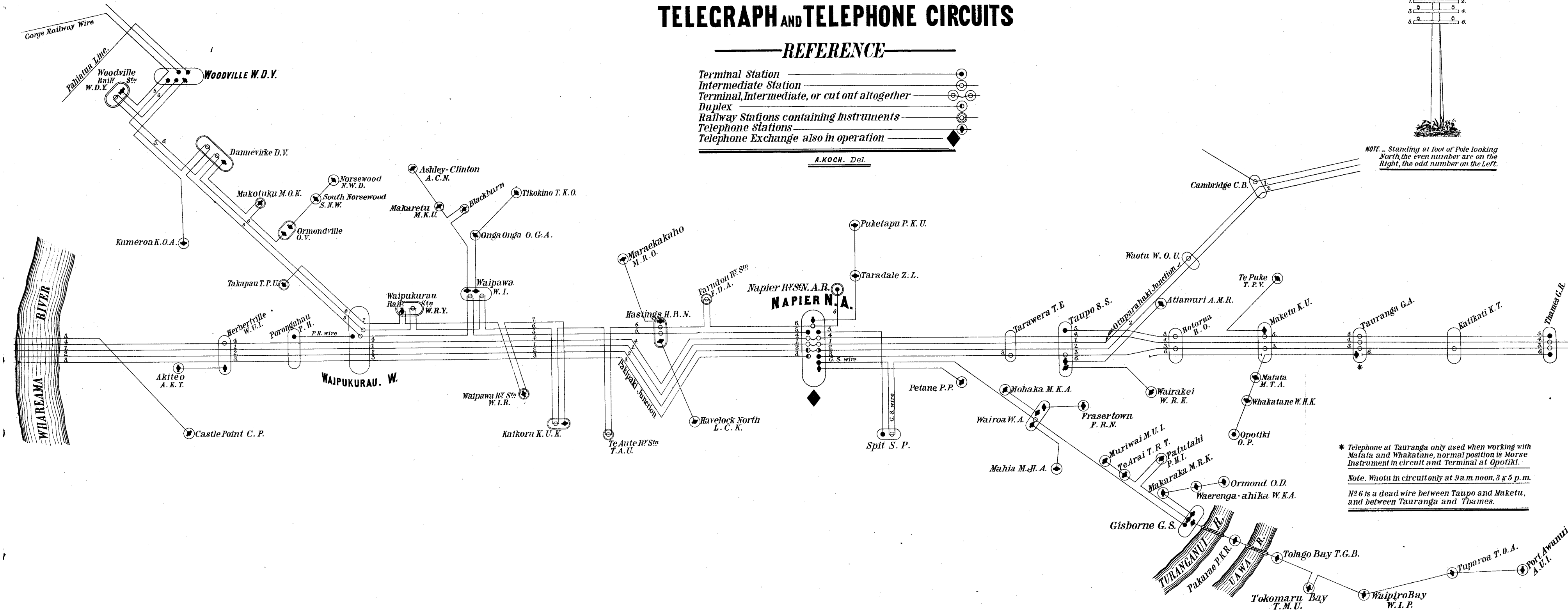

* Telephone at Tauranga only used when working with Matata and Whakatane, normal position is Morse Instrument in circuit and Terminal at Opotiki.

Note. Waotu in circuit only at 9 a.m. noon, 3 & 5 p.m.

Nº 6 is a dead wire between Taupo and Maketu, and between Tauranga and Thames.
