The total amount of the salaries current at the end of 1892 is £315,447, and this amount, divided among 3,340 teachers, gives a quotient of £94 8s. 10d. for average salary, to be compared with £94 2s. 6d. at the end of 1891, and £94 10s. 5d. at the end of 1890.

The number of teachers above the rank of pupil-teacher at the end of 1892 was 2,130. Included in this number are 131 who had not been examined for certificates, and 54 who had failed at examination. There were also 94 who had achieved "partial" success at examination. There were 1,826 certificated teachers, and 25 others who had passed the certificate examination. The proportion of teachers qualified by examination varied from about 50 per cent. (in Marlborough) to very nearly 100 per cent. (in Otago), the mean proportion for the whole of New Zealand being 87 per cent. When the results of the January examination of 1893 are taken into account, it is found that this proportion is raised to 89½ per cent. (1,905 out of 2,130).
