RAILWAY OFFICIALS.

(DETAILS OF SALARIES, ALLOWANCES, APPOINTMENTS, AND PROMOTIONS.)

Return to an Order of the House of Representatives dated 20th September, 1893.

Ordered, "That a return be laid upon the table of this House (in continuation of D.—8 and D.—123, 1893, as to officers in the Railway Department), giving similar information as to salaries down to the 30th June, 1893, and as to travelling-allowances for the last financial year, and for the following three months down to the 30th June, 1893; and for a further return, giving similar information, under both heads of the foregoing returns, as to all officers receiving salaries of £200 per annum and upwards who have been appointed or promoted by the Commissioners subsequent to the 27th January, 1889, down to the 30th June, 1893."—(Mr. G.
