200. Byrne, Patrick (by his widow)	H.M. 65th Regiment ...	40	Claimant received land as a Military Settler; claims also as a Volunteer. There is no proof of period when he served.
201. Byrne, John W. ...	Wairoa Rifles, Militia, &c.	30	No proof of claimant having joined the Militia by command of his superior officer.
202. Byrne, Hugh ...	H.M. 12th Regiment ...	30	Did not settle in the colony on discharge.

219. Chadwick, Joseph ...	Wanganui Cavalry ...	30	Not proved five years' continuous efficient Volunteer service.
220. Charker, Daniel ...	Makara Rifles ...	30	Did not commence Volunteer service until after 31st October, 1876.
221. Chevannes, Charles Huddell	Alexandra Cavalry ...	30	Not five years' continuous efficient service as a Volunteer.
222. Clarkson, John ...	Mauka Ranger Volunteers	30	Has not proved five years' efficient Volunteer service.
223. Climo, James ...	Taranaki Volunteers ...	30	This appears to be a claim for wounds. Claim not established.
