340. Blackstop, George ...	Hawke's Bay Volunteers	30	Not five years' efficient service as a Volunteer in any properly-enrolled Volunteer corps.
341. Boland, Michael ...	Wairoa Rifles ...	30	Has already received land as a Military Settler.
342. Boland, Michael ...	Wairoa Rifles ...	30	This claim is for balance of land on W. Doolan's selection. The claim does not come within the Acts, and has already been dealt with by a clause in Special Powers and Contracts Act of 1882.

352. Hornsby, J. T. Marryat ...	Arrow Rifle Volunteers ...	30	Not five years' continuous service as efficient Volunteer.
