456. Liddle, Major John	2nd Dragoons (Greys)	200	Did not serve in New Zealand, and did not retire from Her Majesty's service until after 31st December, 1872.
457. Littlewood, Private Herbert	H.M. 3rd Dragoon Guards	30	Has already received scrip for Volunteer service. Claims for Imperial service.
458. Lind, Private David	Wanganui Cavalry Volunteers and Aramoho Light Horse	30	Not proved five years' continuous efficient Volunteer service.
459. Lloyd, Sergeant-Major Thomas	Wellington Rangers	40	These were not ordinary Volunteers, but a paid corps, raised to go to the front at the time of Titokowaru's war.
460. Love, Private Theophilus George	Auckland Rifle Volunteers	30	Did not commence service in Wanganui Rifle Corps until after 31st October, 1876.
461. Lowe, Private John	H.M. 88th Regiment	30	Discharged in 1871. Did not come to New Zealand until two years after. Came to New Zealand, November, 1874, as settler in Manchester Block.
462. Love, Private William	H.M. 2nd Battalion, 18th Regiment	30	Character on discharge "bad," owing to intemperance, but otherwise good.
463. Macdonald, Corporal J. S.	Highland Rifle Volunteers	30	Has not proved five years' continuous efficient Volunteer service.
464. Mackintosh, Lance-Corporal C. D.	H.M. 14th Regiment	40	Deserted from his regiment on the 19th February, 1870. Enlisted under age, in the Waikato, and left the regiment in Melbourne.
465. Mafers, Private Henry	Wellington Rifles and Carlyle Rifle Volunteers	30	Not proved five years' continuous efficient Volunteer service.
466. Malcolm, Ensign R. J.	Waimea East Volunteers	30	Service in Nelson, where Volunteer Act of 1865 was not brought into force.
467. Marsh, Lance-Sergeant H. T.	Major Bigg's Corps	30	Not provided for in the Naval and Military Land Acts. This corps was enrolled with fixed rate of pay and no land; were offered lower rate of pay with land, which they refused. No claim.
468. McCafferty, Private Patrick	H.M. 65th Regiment	30	Has already received land for his Imperial service.
469. McGovern, Sub-Constable L.	Royal Irish Constabulary	50	Royal Irish Constabulary is not (according to the Commissioner of Crown Lands) a military service in the meaning of the Acts.
470. McManemin, Private W. B.	Patea Rifle Volunteers	30	Not five years' continuous efficient Volunteer service.
471. Meehan, Private Michael	Wanganui Rifle Volunteers	30	Has not proved five years' efficient Volunteer service.
472. Moir, Private David	Wellington Rifle Volunteers	30	Ditto.
473. Meney, Private Lawrence	H.M. 57th Regiment	30	Discharged with character "indifferent."
474. Mullins, Private Anthony	H.M. 65th Regiment	30	Has already received land for military service in 1864.
475. Murphy, Private John	East Indian Horse Artillery	30	Did not obtain his discharge for the purpose of settling in New Zealand, and did not make claim until after 31st March, 1893.
476. Murphy, Private Martin	Pahautanui Rifles	30	Not proved five years' continuous efficient Volunteer service.
477. Neary, Private Stephen	H.M. 57th Regiment	30	Has received a remission certificate for Imperial service; now claims for service as a Volunteer.
478. Newth, Private Tom N.	Richmond Rifle Volunteers	30	Claim not within the Acts, as the Provincial Council of Nelson did not adopt the Volunteer Act of 1865.
479. Newth, Sergeant R. H. B.	Marlborough Rangers	30	The Volunteer Act of 1865 was not adopted by the Provincial Council of Marlborough.
480. Oswin, Alfred F.	Captain's Clerk, Royal Navy	200	Has not proved that he retired from the Royal Navy for the purpose of settling in New Zealand. Retired from the Royal Navy in 1856; was detained during the Indian Mutiny; came to New Zealand in 1859; has been in the colony ever since.
