## Advertising.

I HAVE the honour, by direction of the Minister of Justice, to transmit herewith a list of the newspapers in your district in which advertisements under the Bankruptcy Act are to be published.

As a general rule advertisements are to be published once only, but in exceptional cases this may be departed from. An explanation of the special circumstances requiring more than one insertion must, however, accompany the voucher.

As regards advertisements in newspapers in places not mentioned in the annexed list, Assignees must use their own discretion, but they should satisfy themselves that a majority of the creditors reside in the district in which the newspapar circulates.

Claims for advertising should be sent in once a month or once a quarter, as may be more convenient, and should be accompanied by copies of the advertisements.
