The Committee to consist of Mr. Crowther, Mr. Green, Major Harris, Mr. Joyce, Mr. J. W. Kelly, Mr. Massey, Mr. McLachlan, Mr. R. McKenzie, Mr. O'Regan, and the mover."—(Hon. Mr. Hall-Jones.)
