4. The uses to which the land has been applied: For investigating diseases in stock, the testing of seeds and plants and the raising of economic plants for distribution to settlers, testing the feeding-values of grasses, and establishing a grass-garden or collection of grasses, so that visitors may see each grass or fodder-plant growing. 2,845 rooted vines and about 3,095 shelter-trees have been distributed, besides a large number planted for shelter on the station.

5. Number of persons employed throughout: (a) maximum, 16; (b) minimum, 6. Rates of salary or wages paid to each class: Curator, £140 per annum; overseer, £120 per annum; carpenter, 8s. per diem; assistant nurseryman, 7s. 6d. per diem; labourers, 7s., 6s. 6d., 5s., and 4s. 6d. per diem; horseman, 5s. 10d. per diem; boy, 3s. 4d. per diem.

6. The number of stock now on the station: 8 horses, for farm-work; 55 cattle, to eat down

rough feed; 492 sheep, for experimental purposes.

7. Returns, £292 17s. 7d. Account-sales for wool not to hand at 31st March.
