I have the honour to submit my report for the year ended 31st March, 1944, in terms of section 109 of the Land for Settlements Act, 1925.

The purchase of land for the settlement of discharged servicemen is of paramount

The purchase of land for the settlement of discharged servicemen is of paramount importance to-day, and until their requirements are met it seems clear that little can be done in the way of purchasing land for subdivision for ordinary settlement.

Purchases for discharged servicemen, ir accordance with Government policy, are being made in terms of the Small Farms Act, 1932-33, and details of purchases made will be found in the annual report on Settlement of Crown Lands (C.-1).

No areas were acquired during the year pursuant to the provisions of the Land for Settlements Act, 1925.
