Sir,—

I have the honour to submit my report for the year ended 31st March, 1946, in terms of section 109 of the Land for Settlements Act, 1925.

The purchase of land for the settlement of discharged servicemen is still of paramount importance, and until their requirements are met little can be done in the way of

purchasing land for subdivision for ordinary settlement.

Purchases of lands for the settlement of discharged servicemen are in accordance with Government policy, being made in terms of the Small Farms Act, 1932-33, while the compulsory acquisition of areas suitable for the settlement of discharged servicemen is arranged under the Servicemen's Settlement and Land Sales Act, 1943. Details of the properties purchased and acquired in this manner will be found in the annual report on Settlement of Crown Lands (C.-1).

No areas were acquired during the year pursuant to the Land for Settlements Act, 1925.
