*Ordered*, "That a Select Committee be appointed, consisting of ten members, to consider all matters pertaining to agricultural and pastoral industries and stock which may be referred to it, with power to confer and sit together with any similar Committee which may be appointed by the Legislative Council, and to agree to a joint or separate report: the Committee to consist of Mr. Cullen, Mr. Gordon, Mr. Gillespie, Mr. Herron, Mr. Holyoake, Mr. Langstone, Mr. McCombs, Mr. Walls, Mr. Williams, and the Mover."—(Hon. Mr. ROBERTS.)
