The workshop at Thornton again had a very busy year attending to the repairs and maintenance of all excavators, tractors, trucks, and cars. One especially large job handled was the dismantling, transport, repair, and re-erection of the Monighan dragline. The weight of this machine is about 35 tons, and its transport across the Rangitaiki River was made more difficult by the cumbersome nature of some of the parts.
