DESCRIPTIONS OF DISTRICTS REFERRED TO ABOVE

 The Central North Island District embraces the country lying to the north of a line commencing at Wanganui, running thence due east to the Manavatu Gorge, and thence in the same direction to Xapier, and bounded on the north by a line running due east from Xawina Harbour to Tautanga.

2. Southern North Island District.—All that portion of the North Island lying to south of the southern boundary of the Central North Island District.

3. Nelson-Monboneuth District.—That portion of the South Island lying to the north of a line commending at the month of the Grey Mives on the wast coast, thene following the left bank of that river to its source, thence along the summit of the Spencer Mountains to the watershed between the sources of the Charener and Sabine Rivers, and thence in a stright line to the nonth of the Conway River.

4. Canterbury District.—All that portion of the South Island to the south of the southern boundary of the Nelson-Marborough District and bounded in the west by the Southern Alps from the point where that range is crossed by the southern boundary of the Nelson-Marborough District to Mount Cook, thence due east to Timaru. 5. Southern Lakes District.—All that portion of the South Island lying to the south

Southern Lukes District.—All that portion of the South Island lying to the south
of the Cantenbury-District and including the west coast south of a line turning due west
from Monut Cook to the sea.
 Cantenbury-Westland District (in table for year ended 31st March, 1949, only).—

6. Canterbury-Westland District (in table for year ended 31st March, 1949, only).—All that portion of the South Island bounded on the north by the southern boundary of the Nelson-Mariborough District and on the south by a line commercing at Makawiho Point, on the west coast (north of Bruce Bay), and there along the divide between the Makawiho and Karangarua Rivers to the main divide at the head of the Muller Glancier, thence in a direct line for Timmer, and on the west and east by the sen.
