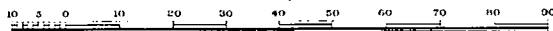


MIDDLE ISLAND NEW ZEALAND

The trawling stations are numbered from 1 up to 154.
The sounding stations are numbered from 1 up to 122.
The nature of the bottom is indicated by the accompanying letters—viz., S, sand;
F.S., fine sand; C.S., coarse sand; D.S., dark sand; Sh, shell; M, mud; G, gravel;
F.G., fine gravel; St, stones; Rk, rock.
