## TRANSACTIONS DURING THE YEAR 1899.

## REGISTRATION OF SOCIETIES AND BRANCHES.

\* The word "Lodge," when applied to all societies, is to be understood as embracing the synonymous terms "Court," "Tent," &c., as used in the various Orders.

17. Statistics of friendly societies everywhere exhibit the effect of the continuous fall in the rate of interest on investments. The income of New Zealand societies has been largely affected by this cause. Notwithstanding that the percentage of capital bearing interest is greater, and that a greater percentage of such capital is invested on mortgage of freehold property, the mode of investment yielding the highest rate of interest, the average rate has declined during ten years  $1\frac{1}{2}$  per cent. As, however, the average rate of interest on mortgages is nearly 6 per cent., it has not been considered necessary to reduce the rate assumed for the purposes of valuation.

20. Societies, on application to the Registrar, may have their valuations made free of cost. The experience of the societies valued in the office during the year represents 12,246 years of life at risk. This experience has been grouped with that published in tabular form in last year's report, and the combined results are exhibited hereunder.
