The *Golden Sand Company* have been working intermittently during the past twelve months. A good deal of time has been devoted to further prospecting. Additions have been made to the plant and other works constructed which are likely to render future mining operations more successful.

Neil and party have been employed for some time past in driving a new tunnel to give them more fall. It will be 1,600 ft. long when completed and boxed throughout, and at the present time is about half finished. A new water-balance will also be erected upon this claim.
