(1) The amount of cocoanut-oil cake imported into New Zealand; (2) the amount of imported oil-cake carried on the railways, and the rate charged; (3) the rate of duty charged on imported cake; and (4) the amount of oil-cake manufactured in New Zealand, sold in New Zealand, carried on the railways, and the rate charged."—
