TRANSACTIONS DURING THE YEAR 1901.

REGISTRATION OF SOCIETIES AND BRANCHES.

18. Societies, on application to the Registrar, may have their valuations made free of cost. The experience of the societies valued in the office during the year represents 25,342·5 years of life at risk. This experience has been grouped with that published in tabular form in last year's report, and the combined results are exhibited hereunder. The sickness of these societies for the quinquennium preceding the valuation date was nearly 5 per cent. in excess of the expectation, a fact which justifies the use of a table of present values based on New Zealand experience.
