REPORT.

To His Excellency the Right Honourable Uchter John Mark, Earl of Ranfurly, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over His Majesty's Colony of New Zealand and its Dependencies.

MAY IT PLEASE YOUR EXCELLENCY,—

We, the members of the North Island Representation Commission appointed by Your Excellency, have the honour to report that we sat on the 8th instant to consider objections relating to the reapportionment of the thirty-four North Island electoral districts and their boundaries.

Forty-one objections and suggestions were received and duly considered and dealt with by the Commissioners in the manner set forth in the attached schedule, and the Commission finally approved and confirmed the apportionment and boundaries of the electoral districts, and now respectfully submit for Your Excellency's consideration the names and descriptions of the same, together with the actual and nominal populations respectively agreeing with the totals as allotted by the Joint Commission.

NORTH ISLAND ELECTORAL DISTRICTS.

BAY OF ISLANDS.

THIS district is bounded towards the north-east generally by the sea from North Cape to the Whananaki Inlet at Sandy Bay: thence towards the south-east generally by the said Whananaki Inlet to Section No. 7, Block V., Opuawhanga Survey District; thence by the said Section No. 7 and Section No. 8 of the said Block V. to the north-western corner of the last-mentioned section; thence by a right line across the Forest Reserve to the north-western corner of Section No. 22, Block VIII., Opuawhanga Survey District; thence by the said Section No. 22 to the south-eastern corner of Section No. 12 of Block VII., Opuawhanga Survey District; thence by parts of the eastern and southern boundary-lines of the said Section No. 12, by the eastern, southern, and western, and again by the southern, boundary-lines of Section No. 23 of the said Block VII.; thence by lines so as to include Sections Nos. 18, 4, 31, 30, and 10 to the north-eastern corner of Section No. 7 of Block VII. aforesaid; thence by the eastern boundary-line of the said Section No. 7 to the north-western corner of Section No. 33 of Block VII. aforesaid; thence by the northern and eastern boundary-lines of the said Section No. 33, by parts of the northern and eastern boundary-lines of Section No. 26 of Block VII. aforesaid, and by the eastern and south-eastern boundary-lines of Section No. 35 of Block VII. aforesaid to Section No. 7, Block XI., Opuawhanga Survey District; thence by the said Section No. 7 and by Sections Nos. 3 and 9 to the road at the northernmost corner of the said Section No. 9; thence by that road and its continuation to Section No. 18; thence by the said Section No. 18, and by the road continuing north-westerly from the last-mentioned section to and along the southern boundaries of Sections Nos. 15 and 17, of Block XII., Hukerenui Survey District, to the eastern portion of Section No. 32 of the said Block XII.; thence by the south-western boundary-lines of Sections Nos. 17, 16, and 2 of Block XII. aforesaid to the Whakapara River; thence by the right bank of the said Whakapara River to the south-western boundary-line of Section No. 12, Block XV., Hukerenui Survey District; thence by the south-western boundary-line of the said Section No. 12 to the road at the north-western boundary of that section; thence by the said road continued westerly to Section No. 20 of Block III., Purua Survey District; thence by the said Section No. 25 and by Sections Nos. 9, 23, 15, and 14 of Otakairanga Parish, and by Section No. 1 of Block I., Purua Survey District, to the road which intersects the last-mentioned section; thence by the last-mentioned road and its continuation in a south-westerly direction, passing Sections Nos. 30, 33, 37, 38, 41, 42, 43, and 44, all of the said Block I., to Section No. 25 of Block I. aforesaid; thence by the said Section No. 25 and Section No. 26 of the said Block I., and by Section No. 13 of Block IV., Mangakahia Survey District, to the Moengawahine River; thence by the said Moengawahine River to its confluence with the Hikurangi River; thence by the said Hikurangi River to its confluence with the Mangakahia River; thence by the right bank of the said Mangakahia River to the westernmost corner of Section No. 3, Block X., Mangakahia Survey District; thence by a right line to Trig. Station 18 on Te Tarahi o Rahiri; thence by a right line to Trig. Station 43 (Tutamoe), Tutamoe Survey District; thence towards the south generally by a right line to the north-eastern corner of State Forest reserve of 7,750 acres, in Tutamoe Survey District; thence by a right line to the north-eastern corner of Section No. 1, Block I., Tutamoe Survey District; thence by the said Section No. 1, and by Sections Nos. 6, 8, 9, 10, 19, 20, 21, and 22 of the Marlborough Special Settlement, to the north-western corner of the last-mentioned section; thence by a right line to the north-eastern corner of the Waipoua No. 2 Block (N.R.), Waipoua Survey District; thence by the said Waipoua No. 2 Block to the sea-coast at Hahaonui: thence towards the south-west by the sea: and towards the north by the sea: including Moturoa, Cavalli, and all adjacent islands.

MARSDEN.

This district is bounded towards the north-west by the Bay of Islands Electoral District, herebefore described, from the westernmost corner of Section No. 3 of Block X., Mangakahia Survey District, to the Whananaki Inlet near Sandy Bay: thence towards the north-east generally by the sea to Tawharanui Point: thence towards the south-east generally by the sea to North Head, Mahurangi Harbour: thence towards the west and east by Mahurangi Harbour to Section No. 91, Parish of Mahurangi, in Block XI., Mahurangi Survey District: thence towards the south generally by the said Section No. 91, and by Sections Nos. 106, 104, 162, and 103 of the said Parish of Mahurangi to the south-western corner of the last-mentioned section: thence by the southern boundary-lines of the eastern and western portions of Section No. 155, and by the road forming the southern boundary of the southern portion of Section No. 159 of the said Parish of Mahurangi, and by that road continued to the Great North Road: thence towards the west by the Great North Road towards Warkworth to its junction with the road leading westerly from Warkworth towards Kaipara Flats: thence again towards the south generally by the last-mentioned road intersecting Sections Nos. 66, 65, 64, 63, 62, 61, and 60, Parish of Mahurangi, and proceeding along the southern boundary of Section No. 15 and intersecting Sections Nos. 11, 12, and 13, Parish of Kourawhero, to the north-western boundary-line of the last-mentioned section; thence by the said Section No. 13 and by Sections Nos. 22, 49, and 48 and the northern portion of Section No. 47 and the northern portion of Section No. 44 of the said Parish of Kourawhero to the Onehunga Stream: thence towards the south-west generally by the said Onehunga Stream to its confluence with the Kourawhero Stream; thence by the said Kourawhero Stream to its confluence with the Kaitoto Stream; thence by the said Kaitoto Stream to its confluence with the Hoteo River; thence by the right bank of the Hoteo River to the easternmost corner of Section No. 111,

Parish of Tauhoa; thence by the said Section No. 111, and by Sections Nos. 128, 80, 79, 78, 77, and 75, to the road forming the western boundary of Section No. 2, Block XVI., Otamatea Survey District; thence by that road to the Port Albert and Mahurangi Road; thence by the last-mentioned road to the Great North Road; thence by the Great North Road to the south-eastern boundary-line of the south-eastern portion of Section No. 118, Parish of Oruawhoro; thence by the said south-eastern portion of Section No. 118 and Section No. 117 of the said Parish of Oruawhoro to the easternmost corner of the last-mentioned section; thence by the said Section No. 117, and by Sections Nos. 116, 105, and 104, all of the Parish of Oruawhoro, to the south-eastern corner of Section No. 104, Parish of Oruawhoro; thence by the said Section No. 104 and Section No. 103 to Te Hana River; thence by the said Te Hana River, the Mainene Creek, and the Topuni River to the crossing of the Great North Road; thence by the Great North Road to the eastern boundary-line of Section No. 147, Parish of Wairau; thence by the south-eastern boundary-line of the said Section No. 147 to the Kaiwaka River; thence by the said Kaiwaka River and the Wairau River to the Waikorere Stream; thence by the said Waikorere Stream to the southernmost corner of the Ohungarere Block (3741); thence by the western boundary-line of the said block and the south-western boundary-line of Subdivision No. 3 of the said Ohungarere Block to its north-western corner; thence by the south-eastern boundary-lines of Sections Nos. 58, 59, 60, 61, and 62, Parish of Wairau, by the south-western boundary-lines of Sections Nos. 62, 63, 73, 74, 151, 86, 85, and 84, all of the Parish of Wairau, to the south-western corner of the last-mentioned section; thence by Sections Nos. 28, 29, 30, 42, 142, and 151, Parish of Paparoa, to the road forming the north-eastern boundary of the last-mentioned section; thence by the said road and its continuation, passing Sections Nos. 151, 152, 150, and 197, to Section No. 146A, Parish of Paparoa; thence by the said Section No. 146A, and Sections Nos. 146, 144, 143, 115, 112, 114, 75, 154, and 155, Parish of Paparoa, and by Sections Nos. 173, 174, 175, 199, 201, and 202, Parish of Matakoho, by the north-eastern portions of Sections Nos. 225 and 226, and by Sections Nos. 262 and 263, Parish of Matakoho, to the Mangonui River; thence by the said Mangonui River to its confluence with the Tauraroa River; thence by the right bank of the said Tauraroa River to the south-western boundary-line of Section No. 18, Parish of Maungakaramea; thence by the south-western boundary-line of the said Section No. 18 and the south-western boundary-line of Sections Nos. 24, 25, 130, and 129 of the last-named parish; thence by the southern boundary-lines of Sections Nos. 87, 88, 89, 90, 91, and 92, all of the Parish of Maungakaramea, to the south-western corner of the last-mentioned section; thence by part of the south-eastern and the whole of the south-western boundary-lines of Section No. 7 of Block I., Tangihua Survey District, to the south-western corner of the said Section No. 7; thence by a right line to Trig. Station 41 (Tangihua); thence by Sections Nos. 10 and 9, Block VIII., Maungaru Survey District, and by the western boundary-line of Section No. 10 of Block IV., Maungaru Survey District, and by the western boundary-line of the Marumaru Block and that line produced to the right bank of the Wairoa River; thence by the said Wairoa River to the north-western boundary-line of the Otutahuna Block; thence by part of the north-western boundary-line of the said Otutahuna Block to Section No. 12 of Block IV., Maungaru Survey District; thence by the south-western boundary-line of the said Section No. 12 to the north-western corner of that section; thence by a right line to the south-eastern corner of Section No. 8, Block XV., Mangakahia Survey District; thence by the southern boundary-lines of Sections Nos. 8, 9, 10, and 11 of the said Block XV., by the western boundary-lines of Sections Nos. 2 and 1 of Block XV. aforesaid, by the western boundary-lines of Sections Nos. 13 and 28, Block XI., Mangakahia Survey District, by the southern and western and part of the north-western boundary-lines of Section No. 4 of Block X. of the said Mangakahia Survey District, and by the western boundary-line of Section No. 3 of the said Block X. to the westernmost corner of that section, the place of commencement: including Mokohinau Island and adjacent islands.

KAIPARA.

This district is bounded towards the north generally by the Bay of Islands Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from Hahaonui on the west coast to the north-western corner of Section No. 3 of Block X., Mangakahia Survey District: thence towards the north-east generally by the Marsden Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to the easternmost corner of the north-eastern portion of Section No. 22, Parish of Ahuroa, in Block IX., Mahurangi Survey District: thence towards the south-east generally by Section No. 13 of the Parish of Kourawhero to the road forming the western boundary of the western portion of Section No. 55 of the Parish of Ahuroa; thence by the said road (old North Road) and its continuation passing Sections Nos. 39, 38, 37, 36, and 35 of the said Parish of Ahuroa to Section No. 17; thence by the said Section No. 17 to Section No. 83 of the said Parish of Ahuroa; thence by the said Section No. 83 and Section No. 87 to the road forming the western boundary of the last-mentioned section; thence by that road and its continuation passing Sections Nos. 87 and 30 to the north-western corner of the said Section No. 30; thence by that section and Section No. 32, Parish of Ahuroa; thence by the said Section No. 32 and by Sections Nos. 31, 28, 25, 24, and 23 of the Parish of Ahuroa aforesaid to Section No. 134, Parish of Puhoi; thence by the said Section No. 134 and by Sections Nos. 50, 115, and 110 of the said Parish of Puhoi to Section No. 111 of the Parish of Waiwera; thence by the said Section No. 111 and by Sections Nos. 118, 117, 116, and 262A of the said Parish of Waiwera to the Waitoki Stream; thence by the said Waitoki Stream to the road forming the southern boundary of Section No. 28 of the Parish of Kaukapakapa; thence by the last-mentioned road to the road intersecting Section No. 27 of the said Parish of Kaukapakapa; thence by lines so as to exclude the said Section No. 27 to the road forming the southern boundary of Section No. 26 of the Parish of Kaukapakapa; thence by the last-mentioned road, and by the road forming the western boundaries of Sections Nos. 52, 57, 58, and 63 of the Parish of Kaukapakapa to Section No. 65; thence by the said Section No. 65 and by Section No. 66 of the Parish of Kaukapakapa, and by Section No. 307,

Parish of Pukeatua, to Section No. 84, Parish of Pukeatua; thence by the said Section No. 84, and Sections Nos. 83, 60, 308, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 40, 41, and 37 all of the Parish of Pukeatua, to the south-western corner of the last-mentioned section; thence by the south-western boundary-line of Sections Nos. 36 and 35 of the Parish of Pukeatua to the south-western corner of the said Section No. 35; thence by a right line to the northernmost corner of Section No. 54 of the Parish of Ararimu; thence by the said Section No. 54 and by Sections Nos. 55 and 60 of the said Parish of Ararimu to the Waikoukou Stream; thence by the said Waikoukou Stream to its confluence with the Kumeu River; thence by the said Kumeu River to the road which intersects Section No. 50 of the Parish of Paremoremo; thence by the said road through the Waikoukou Block in a southerly direction to the Auckland-Helensville Railway-line; thence by the Auckland-Helensville Railway-line to the Waipatukahu Stream; thence by the said Waipatukahu Stream to the Uhurua Block, in Block VI., Kumeu Survey District; thence by the said Uhurua Block to its south-western corner; and thence by a line due west to the sea-coast: and thence towards the south-west by the sea-coast to Hahaonui, the place of commencement.

This district is bounded towards the north-west generally by the Kaipara Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the sea-coast at a point due west of the south-western corner of Uhurua Block, Kumeu Survey District, to the easternmost corner of the north-eastern portion of Section No. 22 of the Parish of Ahuroa; thence towards the north-east generally by the Marsden Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to North Head, Mahurangi Harbour: thence towards the north-east generally by the sea to the North Head, Waitemata Harbour: thence towards the south and towards the east by the said Waitemata Harbour and the Whau River to the northernmost corner of Section No. 90 of the Parish of Waikomiti; thence towards the south-east by the said Section No. 90 of the Parish of Waikomiti to Canty's Stream; thence by the said Canty's Stream to Section No. 6 of the said Parish of Waikomiti; thence by the said Section No. 6 and Sections Nos. 7, 8, 9, and 10 of the said Parish of Waikomiti to the westernmost corner of the last-mentioned section; thence by a right line to the north-eastern corner of Section No. 368 of the said Parish of Waikomiti; thence by Sections Nos. 368, 93, and 94 of the said Parish of Waikomiti, and by Sections Nos. 36, 74, 73, 37, and 38 of the Parish of Karangahape, to the easternmost corner of the Piha Block; thence by the southern boundary-line of the said Piha Block to the sea-coast: and thence towards the south-west by the sea-coast to a point due west of the south-western corner of the Uhurua Block aforesaid, the place of commencement: including Tiritiri Island, Bean Rock, Great Barrier Island, Little Barrier Island, Kawau Island, Motuhora Island, Pine Island, and adjacent islands.

CITY OF AUCKLAND.

This district is bounded towards the north-west and north-east generally by a line commencing in the middle of Franklin Street, at the original high-water mark of Freeman's Bay, and proceeding along right lines measuring respectively 50 links, 300 links, 1225 links, 700 links, 270 links, 4300 links, 1735 links, 82 links, 250 links, 758 links, 852 links, 1171 links, 1059 links, and 1800 links: thence towards the east by a right line, 1500 links, to the Strand; thence by the Strand, 50 links; thence to and by Suburban Section No. 96; thence by a line to and thence by the east side of Stanley Street to the Government Domain; thence by the Government Domain and the Hospital Reserve to the road known as Park Road; thence by the northern side of said Park Road to a point in line with the eastern boundary-line of Allotment No. 22 of Section No. 3 of the Suburbs of Auckland; thence by a right line to and by said boundary-line and by its production to the south side of Carlton Gore Road; thence by the south side of the said road to the western boundary-line of subdivisional Lot No. 37 of original Allotment No. 4 of Section No. 3 of the Suburbs of Auckland; thence by Lot No. 37 aforesaid, and by Lots Nos. 55, 56, 65, 66, 75, 76, 85, 86, 95, 96, 105, 106, 115, 116, and 13, all of the original Allotment No. 4 of the said Section No. 3 of the Suburbs of Auckland, and by the western boundary-line of Allotment No. 13, before mentioned, produced to the southern side of Kyber Pass Road; thence by the said Kyber Pass Road to the eastern side of the road leading to the Mount Eden Stockade: thence generally towards the south-east by the eastern side of the said road to its junction with the Mount Eden Road: thence towards the south-west generally by the southern side of the Mount Eden Road to Symonds Street; thence by a line to and by Basque Road and by Sections Nos. 4 and 13 to the Great North Road; thence by a line across the Great North Road to the intersection of the northern side of that road with the eastern side of Pollen Street, Borough of Grey Lynn; thence by the said Pollen Street to the north side of Rose Road in the Borough of Grey Lynn; thence by the said Rose Road to the eastern side of McKelvie Street in the Borough of Grey Lynn; and thence by the said McKelvie Street to Ponsonby Road; thence by the west side of the said Ponsonby Road to its junction with Richmond Road; and thence by the south side of Richmond Road to the left bank of Cox's Creek, and by the left bank of that creek to the Waitemata Harbour: thence again towards the north-west and the north-east generally by high-water mark of Waitemata Harbour to the place of commencement.

GREY LYNN.

This district is bounded towards the north-east generally by Cox's Bay and Cox's Creek and the City of Auckland Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from Waitemata Harbour to the junction of Normanby Road with Quarry Road: thence towards the east generally by the said Normanby Road to the Auckland-Kaipara Railway-line; thence by the said Auckland-Kaipara Railway-line to the western side of Mount Eden Road; thence by the said Mount Eden Road to The Terrace dividing Allotments 12 and 13: thence towards the south generally by The Terrace and its continuation to View Road; thence by the said View Road to its junction with Mount

Roskill Road; thence by the said Mount Roskill Road for about 13 chains to the road which forms the south-western boundary of subdivisional Allotment No. 8; thence by the last-mentioned road and its continuation to the New North Road; thence by the New North Road to its junction with the Western Springs Road; thence by the said Western Springs Road to Allotment No. 38 of Section No. 5 of the Suburbs of Auckland; and thence towards the south-west generally by the said Allotment No. 38, by Allotment No. 40 of the said Section No. 5, and by Allotment No. 21 of Section No. 7 of the Suburbs of Auckland to the Old Great North Road; thence by the southern side of the old Great North Road to a point in line with the south-western boundary-line of Allotment No. 14 of Section No. 9, Suburbs of Auckland; thence by a right line to the south-western corner of the said Allotment No. 14; and thence by the south-western boundary-line of Allotment No. 14 aforesaid, and by the south-eastern and south-western boundary-lines of Allotment No. 12 of Section No. 9 aforesaid, to the northernmost corner of Allotment No. 13 of Section No. 9 aforesaid; thence by the north-western boundary-line of that allotment to Motion's Creek, and by that creek to the Waitemata Harbour aforesaid; and thence towards the north generally by Waitemata Harbour to Cox's Bay aforesaid, the place of commencement.

EDEN.

This district is bounded towards the north-west generally by the Waitemata Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the west coast at the south-western corner of the Piha Block in Waitakerei Survey District to the Whau River; thence by Sections Nos. 8A and 20 of the Parish of Waipareira to the north-eastern corner of the said Section No. 20: thence towards the north by a right line in an easterly direction to Point Chevalier; thence by Waitemata Harbour and Motion's Creek to the north-western boundary-line of Allotment No. 13 of Section No. 9 of the Suburbs of Auckland: thence towards the north-east generally by the Grey Lynn Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to Normanby Road: thence again towards the north by the City of Auckland Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to the Kyber Pass Road at the boundary of the Borough of Newmarket: thence again towards the north-east by the Borough of Newmarket (as the said borough is described in the *New Zealand Gazette* No. 30, 7th May, 1885) to the Epsom Road; thence by the said Epsom Road to its junction with the Great South Road; thence by the Great South Road to the junction of roads at the Harp of Erin Inn: thence towards the south-east by the road leading westerly from the Great South Road, passing through Allotment No. 7 and along the north-western boundaries of Allotments Nos. 17A, 16, 15, 14A, 14, to and through Allotment No. 13, and along the south-eastern boundary of the Hospital Reserve (Allotment part of 13) to the junction of roads at the Royal Oak Hotel; thence by the northern side of the last-mentioned road produced to the southern side of Mount Smart Road at the boundary of the Borough of Onehunga: thence towards the south-west and towards the east by the Borough of Onehunga (as the said borough is described in the *New Zealand Gazette* No. 5, 20th January, 1882) to Manukau Harbour: thence again towards the south-east generally by Manukau Harbour to Manukau Heads: and thence towards the west by the sea to the south-western corner of the Piha Block aforesaid.

PARNELL.

This district is bounded to the north-west generally by the City of Auckland Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the Kyber Pass Road to the easternmost corner of the City of Auckland; thence by the north-western boundary-line of the Borough of Parnell to St. George's Bay: thence towards the north generally by the waters of Waitemata Harbour to the Tamaki River: thence towards the east generally by the said Tamaki River to the southernmost corner of Lot No. 17 of Section No. 4 of Small Lots near Panmure: thence towards the south by the road which forms the southern boundary of Lots Nos. 17, 16, 15, 14, 13, 12, 11, 10, 9, 8, 7, and 6 of the said Section No. 4 to the road which forms the north-western boundary of the last-mentioned lot; thence by the last-mentioned road to its junction with the road which forms the south-western boundary of Lot No. 39 of Section No. 1 of Small Lots near Panmure; thence by the last-mentioned road and its continuation in a westerly direction, passing Small Lot No. 40 and Allotments Nos. 31 and 32 of Section No. 12, Parish of Waitemata, to the Great South Road near Penrose Junction: thence towards the south-west by the Great South Road to the boundary of the Eden Electoral District near the Harp of Erin Inn; and thence by the Eden Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to the Kyber Pass Road aforesaid, the place of commencement.

MANUKAU.

This district is bounded towards the north-west generally by the Eden Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from Manukau Harbour to the Harp of Erin Inn: thence towards the north-east and towards the north by the Parnell Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to the Tamaki River at the southernmost corner of Lot No. 17 of Section No. 4 of the Small Lots near Panmure; thence by a line due east across the Tamaki River to its eastern shore: thence towards the north-west by the said Tamaki River to the sea: thence again towards the north-east by the sea to the Firth of Thames: thence towards the east by the Firth of Thames to Pukorokoro Creek: thence towards the south by Section No. 82, Block VI., Wharekawa Survey District, and by the road which leads in a westerly direction from that section, passing the Miranda Redoubt and the Esk Redoubt, to the river which forms the eastern boundary of Section No. 118 of Block XVI., Opaheke Survey District: thence towards the south-west generally by that river to the northern boundary-line of Section No. 163 of the said Block XVI.; thence by the said Section No. 163 and by Sections Nos. 40 and 39 of Block XVI. aforesaid to the north-western corner of the last-mentioned section; thence by the south-western boundary-line of the Wharekawa No. 2 Block to a point due east of the south-eastern corner of Section No. 73 of Block XI., Opaheke Survey District; thence by the said Section No. 73 and by Sections Nos. 48B

and 34 of Block XI. aforesaid to the Mangatawhiri River; thence by the said Mangatawhiri River to the north-western corner of Section No. 48A (timber reserve); thence by a right line to the north-eastern corner of Section No. 12 of Block VII., Opaheke Survey District; thence again towards the east by the eastern boundary-lines of the said Section No. 12 and the eastern boundary-line of Section No. 13 of Block XI., Opaheke Survey District, to the south-eastern corner of the last-mentioned section: thence again towards the south by the southern boundary-line of the said Section No. 13 to the road forming the western boundary of that section: thence towards the west by the said road and its continuation to the northern corner of Section No. 130, Parish of Opaheke, Opaheke Survey District: thence towards the south-east generally by the road forming the western boundary of the said Section No. 130 to Section No. 129; thence by the said Section No. 129 to the road forming the north-western boundary of that section; thence by the last-mentioned road and that road continued to Section No. 117 of the said Parish of Opaheke, Opaheke Survey District: thence again towards the south by Sections Nos. 117, 116, 115, 245, and 246 of the said Parish of Opaheke to the road forming the north-eastern boundary of Section No. 172 of the Parish of Opaheke aforesaid; thence by the last-mentioned road to Section No. 171 of the Parish of Opaheke, Opaheke Survey District; thence by the said Section No. 171 and by Sections Nos. 169 and 166 of the said Parish of Opaheke to the road at the eastern boundary of Section No. 164; thence by that road and its continuation passing Sections Nos. 164, 213, 116, 117, 102, 95, and 98, and intersecting Sections Nos. 49 and 50, all of the Parish of Opaheke, to the Great South Road: thence towards the south-west generally by the Great South Road to the Hingaia River; thence by the Hingaia River and the Pahurehure River to Manukau Harbour; thence by Manukau Harbour to the Mangere Bridge; thence by the said Mangere Bridge to the northern shore of Manukau Harbour; and thence by the northern shore of Manukau Harbour to the western boundary of the Borough of Onehunga at the Eden Electoral District aforesaid, the place of commencement: including Ponui Island, Waiheke Island, Rotoroa Island, Pakatoa Island, Pahiki Island, Rakino Island, Motutapu Island, Rangitoto Island, Motuihi Island, Brown's Island, and adjacent islands.

FRANKLIN.

This district is bounded towards the north generally by the Manukau Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the mouth of the Pahurehure River to the Firth of Thames: thence towards the east by a right line to the easternmost corner of Section No. 1 of Block VIII., Wharekawa Survey District; thence by a right line to the northernmost corner of Section No. 1 of Block XI., Piako Survey District; thence by the north-eastern boundary-lines of Sections Nos. 1 and 2 of the said Block XI.; thence by the southern boundary-line of the last-named section to the line known as the confiscation boundary-line; thence by the confiscation boundary-line to a point due west of the summit of Te Aroha Mountain: thence again towards the north generally by a right line in the direction of the summit of Te Aroha Mountain to the left bank of the Waitoa River; thence by the said Waitoa River to its confluence with the Piraunui Stream; thence by the said Piraunui Stream to its confluence with the Waiwhero Stream; and thence by the right bank of the said Waiwhero Stream to the north-western corner of Section No. 6 of Te Kapara Block; thence by the north-western boundary-line of the said Te Kapara Block and by the street forming the south-eastern boundary of the Waihou Township to the north-eastern boundary-line of Section No. 6 of Te Kapara Block, in Block XI., Aroha Survey District; thence by the north-eastern boundary-line of the said Section No. 6 to the road which forms the south-eastern boundary of Section No. 97: thence towards the north-west by that road and the road forming the south-eastern boundary of Sections Nos. 90, 89, 100, and 101: thence towards the south-west by the road forming the north-eastern boundary of Sections Nos. 101, 102, 103, 44, 43, 32, and 33 to the road forming the southern boundary of Section No. 99: thence towards the north by that road and the road forming the southern boundary of the following sections—viz.: Nos. 102, 103, 103, 5 (south portion of), 7, 26, 27, 28, 29, and 40, in Block XI., Aroha Survey District, and the south side of the last-mentioned road produced to the Waihou River; thence towards the north-east by the Waihou River to the south-eastern corner of the Waiharakeke West No. 2B Block; thence towards the south-west by a right line in the direction of the easternmost corner of the Pourewa Block in the Maungakawa Survey District as far as the Waitoa River: thence towards the west by the said Waitoa River to where it is crossed by the Hamilton—Te Aroha Railway-line: thence again towards the south-east generally by the said Hamilton—Te Aroha Railway-line to Tatua Railway-station; thence by the road leading south-westerly passing Murray's Railway-station to the Piako River; thence by the said Piako River to its confluence with the Topehake River; thence by the said Topehake River to its confluence with the Waitakarura River; thence by a right line to the southernmost corner of the Township of Morrinsville; thence by the south-western boundary-line of the Township of Morrinsville to the road leading westerly from Morrinsville; thence by that road and its continuation westerly, passing Motumaoho Railway-station, and intersecting the Kuranui Block and the Mangaotupua Block to a right line joining Hapuakohe and Pukemoremore Trig. Stations known as the confiscation boundary-line; thence by that line to the Hamilton—Te Aroha Railway-line; thence by the Hamilton—Te Aroha Railway-line to the road forming the south-western boundaries of Section No. 241 of the Parish of Kirikiriroa, Komakorau Survey District: thence again towards the south-west generally by that road to its junction with the road forming the south-eastern boundary of Section No. 196 of the said parish; thence by the last-mentioned road and its continuation westerly to the road forming the western boundary of Section No. 192 of the Parish of Kirikiriroa aforesaid; thence by the road forming the western boundaries of Sections Nos. 192, 191, 190, 189, 188, 187, 186, 184, 182, 149, 148, 147, 146, 145, 144, 143, 142, 141, 140, 139, 138, 137, 86, 85, 84, and 83 of the Parish of Kirikiriroa to Tunawhakepeke Lake; thence by the western shore of that lake to the north-eastern boundary-line of Section No. 82 of the said Parish of Kirikiriroa; thence by the said Sections Nos. 82, 76, and 75 to the road at the north-western boundary of the last-

mentioned section: thence towards the south generally by the road forming the northern boundaries of Sections Nos. 75, 73, 25, 24, 23, 22, 13A, 13, 12, 1, 2, and 3 of the Parish of Kirikiriroa aforesaid to the Waikato River: thence again towards south-west by the Waikato River to its confluence with the Waipa River: thence towards the east by the Waipa River to the mouth of the Te Pake Stream: thence again towards the south-east by the said Te Pake Stream to the north-western boundary-line of Section No. 64 of the Parish of Waipa; thence by the said Section No. 64 to a point due south of the easternmost corner of Section No. 62 of the said Parish of Waipa: thence again towards the south-west generally by a line due north to the easternmost corner of the said Section No. 62; thence by Section No. 62 aforesaid, and Sections Nos. 55, 74, 73, 71, 72, 33, 56, and 59, all of the said Parish of Waipa, to Te Akau No. 2 Block (6350), in the Whaingaroa Survey District; thence by the said Te Akau No. 2 Block to the Mangati Stream; and thence by the said Mangati Stream to the sea: thence towards the west by the sea to Manukau Harbour: and thence again towards the north generally by Manukau Harbour to the Pahurehure River, the place of commencement.

THAMES.

This district is bounded towards the north-east generally by the sea, from Cape Colville to the North Head of Tairua Harbour: towards the south-west by a right line drawn in a north-westerly direction from the North Head of Tairua Harbour in the direction of the source of the Waikawau River as far as the Waiwawa River: thence towards the south-east generally by the said Waiwawa River and its tributary the Taitoko Stream to the source of the latter; thence by the Waiwhakauranga and Mangarehu Blocks (formerly timber leases of 14,186 acres and 1,825 acres respectively) to the Mangakirikiri No. 1 Block (No. 3387A); thence by that block to its southernmost corner; thence by the summit of the range leading to the north-eastern corner of Section No. 2, Block V., Thames Survey District; thence by the eastern boundary-lines of the said Section No. 2, and by the eastern boundary-lines of the Hape North No. 1 (2599) and by the eastern boundary-line of the Hape North No. 2 Block (2600), and by part of the north-eastern boundary-line of the Hape South No. 1 Block (2601A) to the Mangakirikiri No. 3 Block (3389A); thence by the said Mangakirikiri No. 3 Block to the Waikiekie Stream; thence by the left bank of the said Waikiekie Stream to the south-western boundary-line of the Whakairorahi No. 1 Block (1667); thence by the said Whakairorahi No. 1 Block, and by the Whakairorahi No. 2 Block (1667A), and by Block No. 2652A to the Waiwhakauranga River; thence by the said Waiwhakauranga River to its confluence with the Kauaeranga River, and thence by the said Kauaeranga River to the Firth of Thames: thence towards the west generally by the Firth of Thames to the southern boundary-line of the Borough of Thames (as the said borough is described in the *New Zealand Gazette* No. 16, 7th February, 1896); thence by the southern, south-western, and northern boundary-lines of the said Borough of Thames to Rocky Point; and thence by the Firth of Thames and the Hauraki Gulf to Cape Colville, the place of commencement: including Great Mercury, Cuvier, and adjacent islands.

OHINEMURI.

This district is bounded towards the north-west and north-east by the Thames Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the southern boundary of the Borough of Thames (as the said borough is described in the *New Zealand Gazette* No. 16, 7th February, 1896) at the Firth of Thames to the northern head of Tairua Harbour: thence towards the east generally by the Tairua Harbour and the sea to the easternmost corner of the Whangamata No. 6 Block, near Whiritoa: thence towards the south-east generally by the south-eastern boundary-line of the said Whangamata No. 6 Block to the easternmost corner of Block No. 20c (3416), and thence by the south-eastern boundary-line of the last-mentioned block and the south-eastern boundary-line of Ohinemuri No. 20 Block to the south-eastern corner of the said Ohinemuri No. 20 Block at Trig. Station 86, in Block XI., Ohinemuri Survey District; thence by a right line to the northernmost corner of Section No. 4 of Block XV. of the said Ohinemuri Survey District; thence by a right line to the Ohinemuri River where that river is crossed by the main road to Katikati and Tauranga; thence by the said main road to the south-eastern boundary-line of Ngatitamatua Block; thence by the south-eastern boundary-line of the last-mentioned block to the south-eastern corner of the said Ngatitamatua Block; thence by a line due south to its intersection by a right line drawn from the mouth of the Waihi River to the summit of Te Aroha Mountain; thence by a right line in the direction of the summit of Te Aroha Mountain as far as the summit of the main range between the Waihou River and the Bay of Plenty; thence by the summit of the main range between the Waihou River and the Bay of Plenty (confiscation boundary-line) to Mimiatohanganga at or near the north-western corner of the Whakamarama No. 2 Block: thence again towards the south-east by a right line to the Wairere Falls; thence by the Wairere River: thence towards the south-west by the said Wairere River to its confluence with the Waihou River; and thence by the Waihou River to the Franklin Electoral District: thence towards the south and towards the west generally by the Franklin Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to the Firth of Thames: and towards the north by the Firth of Thames to the southern boundary-line of the Borough of Thames, the place of commencement: including Slipper Island.

WAIKATO.

This district is bounded towards the north generally by the Franklin Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the west coast at the mouth of the Mangati Stream to the Waihou River: thence towards the north-east by the Ohinemuri Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to the Whakamarama No. 2 Block: thence towards the east generally by the said Whakamarama No. 2 Block to its southernmost corner at Waianuanu; thence by the Mangatotara No. 1A Block (5319A), by the Mangatotara No. 1c Block (5319), by a block of Crown lands containing 870 acres, and by

the Mangatotara No. 3 Block (5319c) to the Tauranga Road passing through the Kumikumi No. 1 Block; thence by that road in a westerly direction to where it crosses the Waihou River at the Tuaraparaharaha No. 2 Block (4087); thence by the said Waihou River to the road intersecting the Mangapouri No. 1 Block in the Patetere North Survey District; thence by the last-mentioned road and its continuation in a southerly direction to and along the western boundary of Section No. 2 of the Whakarata-maiti Block in Blocks VII. and XI., Patetere North Survey District, to and across the Oraka Stream and onwards to and across the Auckland-Rotorua Railway-line to the old railway-line at a point about one mile and three-quarters north of the Township of Lichfield; thence by the old railway-line to the northern boundary of the Township of Lichfield; thence by the northern, eastern, and southern boundaries of the Township of Lichfield aforesaid to the road leading in a southerly direction from Lichfield through the Pakuranga No. 1 Block; thence by that road and its continuation leading past Te Whetu No. 1 Block and the Tokoroa No. 1 Block to a right line joining Uraura Trig. Station and Maungatautari Trig. Station (the said right line being the south-western boundary-line of the County of Piako); thence by a right line to Uraura Trig. Station; thence by a right line to the mouth of the Waihora Stream in Lake Taupo; thence towards the south-west by a right line to the source of the Ongaruhe River: thence towards the south by a right line to the summit of Rangitoto Mountain; thence by a right line to the northernmost corner of Te Kuiti Village Settlement; thence by Te Kuiti Village Settlement and by the north-western boundary-line of Section No. 1 of the said Te Kuiti Village Settlement produced to the Mangaokewa Stream; thence by the Mangaokewa River to the south-eastern boundary-line of Section No. 12 of Block XV., Orahiri Survey District: thence towards the south generally by the south-eastern boundary-line of the said Section No. 12 and by the south-eastern boundary-line of Section No. 3 of the said Block XV.; thence by the eastern, southern, and western boundary-lines of the Tapui-wahine Block to the Pakeho Block (6782); thence by the southern boundary-line of that block and the southern boundary-line of Rototapu Block to the Pokeho Block; thence by the eastern, southern, and part of the western boundaries of the last-mentioned block to the southern boundary-line of the Pokirangi Block; thence by the southern boundary-line of the Pokirangi Block to Subdivision No. 11 of the Kinohaku East No. 2 Block; thence by the south-western boundary-line of the said Subdivision No. 11 to Subdivision No. 25 of the Kinohaku East No. 2 Block; thence by the south-eastern and southern boundary-lines of the said Subdivision No. 25 to Section No. 8 of Block IV., Maungamangero Survey District; thence by the eastern boundary-line of the last-mentioned section to Section No. 7 of the said Block IV.; thence by the said Section No. 7 and by Sections Nos. 2 and 1 of the said Block IV., and by Section No. 13 of Block VIII. of the said survey district, and by Sections Nos. 5, 4, 3, and 1 of Block VII., of Maungamangero Survey District aforesaid, to the northernmost corner of the last-mentioned section; thence by a right line to the south-eastern corner of the Moeatoa Block; and thence by the southern boundary-line of that block to the sea-coast near Tirua Point: and thence towards the west generally by the sea to the Mangati Stream aforesaid.

BAY OF PLENTY.

This district is bounded towards the west generally by the Ohinemuri Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the north-western corner of the Whakamarama No. 2 Block to the Bay of Plenty, at the south-eastern corner of Whangamata No. 6 Block: thence towards the north generally by the Bay of Plenty to Cape Runaway: thence towards the east by a right line to the summit of Mount Hikurangi: thence towards the south-east by right lines from hill to hill along the summit of the watershed between the Bay of Plenty and the east coast to Trig. Station No. 139A; thence by a right line over Trig. Station No. 140 to the Motu River; thence by the right bank of the said Motu River to the north-western boundary-line of the Motu Block; thence by that block to its westernmost corner at the Koranga River: thence again towards the north-east by the right bank of the said Koranga River to its source; thence by a right line to Maungatapere Trig. Station: thence again towards the south-east by a right line to Maungapohatu: thence again towards the north-east by a right line to Trig. Station No. 93 (Nga Pakira): thence again towards the south-east by a right line to the most northerly point of Waikaremoana; thence by a right line to the junction of the Rangitaiki River with the main road from Napier to Taupo; thence by a right line to the eastern boundary-line of the Tauhara South Block to a point where it is crossed by the Taharua River: thence again to the north-east by the said Taharua River to its confluence with the Mohaka River; thence by the said Mohaka River to a line being the production of a right line drawn between Trig. Station No. 65A, Kaweka Survey District, and Trig. Station No. 68A; thence by a right line to the said Trig. Station No. 65A: thence towards the south by a right line to Trig. Station No. 26, Tawhaketewhango; thence by a right line to Trig. Station No. 27; thence by a right line to Trig. Station No. 28, Kaimanawa Survey District; thence by a right line to the summit of Ruapehu Mountain: thence towards the west by lines from peak to peak to the summit of Tongariro Mountain: thence towards the north-west by the Egmont Electoral District, herein-after described, to the mouth of the Waihora Stream on Lake Taupo: and thence towards the west generally by the Waikato Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to the Ohinemuri Electoral District aforesaid: including Motiti and Whale Islands.

WAIAPU.

This district is bounded towards the north by the sea from Cape Runaway to East Cape: towards the east by the sea to Paritu at the southernmost corner of Cook County: thence towards the south-west by a right line to the confluence of the Ruakituri with the Hangaroa River; thence by the right bank of the said Ruakituri River to the north-eastern corner of the Matakuhia Block; and thence by the said Matakuhia Block to Trig. Station 93 (Nga Pakira), on the boundary of the Bay of Plenty Electoral District, hereinbefore described: and thence towards the north-west generally by the said Bay of Plenty Electoral District to Cape Runaway.

HAWKE'S BAY.

This district is bounded towards the north-east by the Waiapu Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the north-western corner of Matakuhia Block to Paritu: thence towards the south-east generally by the sea to a point in line with the northern boundary-line of Section No. 107, Western Spit, Napier; thence by a right line to the northernmost corner of the said Section No. 107; thence by that section and its northern boundary-line produced across the Main North Road to the eastern shore of the inner harbour; thence by the eastern shore of the inner harbour to the Petane Bridge; thence by the said bridge to West Quay, Borough of Napier; thence by West Quay to Battery Point; thence by the eastern shore of Ahuriri Harbour to the bridge at Goa Bay; thence by the road leading from the said bridge across the Mud Flats, and passing Blocks Nos. 124 and 125, to a point in line with the south-eastern boundary-line of Block No. 96; thence by a right line to the south-eastern boundary-line of the said Block No. 96; thence by that block and the southern shore of the said Ahuriri Harbour to the northern boundary-line of Section No. 40, Meeanee Suburban Section; thence by the said Section No. 40 and Sections Nos. 1 and 2, and Block No. 94; thence by Sections Nos. 41, 43, 60, 61, 62, 63, and 64, Meeanee Suburban Sections, and by Block I., Puketapu, to its south-western corner; thence by the left bank of the Tutaekuri River to the road leading from Redcliffe; thence southerly by that road over the Tutaekuri River passing Wai-o-Hiki and the Native Pa to the road at the north-eastern boundary of Section No. 7 of Block XI., Harataunga Survey District; thence by the last-mentioned road and its continuation in an easterly direction to and along the north-western boundary of the Korokipo Block: thence towards the north-east generally by the said Korokipo Block, and by the Ohikakarewa Block to the Ohiwia Stream at Te Rere; thence by the left bank of the Ohiwia Stream to its confluence with the Ngaruroro River; thence by the said Ngaruroro River to a point in line with the north-eastern boundary-line of Section No. 9 of West Clive rural sections; thence by a right line to the northernmost corner of the said Section No. 9; thence by the north-eastern boundary-line of Section No. 9 aforesaid to Section No. 22, West Clive suburban section; thence by Sections Nos. 14, 13, 12, 11, 10, 9, and 8 of West Clive suburban sections to the road, which forms the north-eastern boundary of the last-mentioned section; thence by that road continued in a south-easterly direction to and along the south-western boundary of the Township of Clive and by the southern side of the said road produced to the Tukituki River; thence by the said Tukituki River to Hawke Bay; thence by Hawke Bay to Cape Kidnappers; thence again towards the south-east by the sea to the northern boundary-line of Block No. 40 in the Purerere Survey District: thence towards the south-west generally by the said Block No. 40, and Blocks Nos. 39, 38, 37, and 36, all in the said Purerere Survey District, and Blocks Nos. 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, and 29, all in the Oero Survey District, to the Mangarara Stream; thence by that stream to its confluence with the Tukituki River; thence by the said Tukituki River to the Waipawa and Taumumu Road; thence by that road to the junction of the Patangata and Taumumu Roads; thence by a right line to the easternmost corner of Block 14; thence by the north-eastern boundary-line of that block to the Main South Road; thence by the Main South Road to the Kairourou North Town District (as the said town district is described in *New Zealand Gazette* No. 65, 16th December, 1886); thence by the said Kairourou North Town District to the road intersecting Block 51, Waipukurau Survey District; thence by the said road in a westerly direction through Block 51 aforesaid, and through Blocks 49, 18, 132, 15, 142, 131, 17, 21, 23, all of Waipukurau Survey District, to the Manga-o-nuku River; thence by that river to its confluence with the Mangamouku River; thence by the said Mangamouku River to its source; thence by a right line to the confluence of the north branch of the Waipawa River with the Makaroro Stream; thence by the north branch of the said Waipawa River to its source; thence by a line due west to the summit of the Ruahine Range: thence towards the west generally by the summit of the Ruahine Range to Trig. Station No. 9; thence by a right line to the confluence of the Kaianu Stream with the Taruarau River; and thence by the said Taruarau River to the Ngawaiwhetu Stream; thence by that stream to a right line joining Trig. Stations Nos. 65A and 26: and thence towards the north-west generally by the Bay of Plenty Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to the north-western corner of the Matakuhia Block aforesaid, including Portland Island.

NAPIER.

This district is bounded towards the north and east by Hawke Bay; towards the south generally by the Hawke's Bay Electoral District, hereinbefore described; and towards the west and north-west generally by the said Hawke's Bay Electoral District.

WAIPAWA.

This district is bounded towards the north-east generally by the Hawke's Bay Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the summit of the Ruahine Range to the northern boundary-line of Block No. 40 in the Purerere Survey District: thence towards the south-east by the sea to the southern boundary-line of the Arataura Block at Arataura: thence towards the south-west generally by the southern boundary-line of the said Arataura Block to its south-western corner; thence by Blocks Nos. 19, 49, 26, 50, 21, 30, 55, 56, 59, and 58, all in the Tautane Survey District, to Section No. 4, Block I., Tautane Survey District; thence by the said Section No. 4 and Sections Nos. 3 and 2 of the said Block I. to the northernmost corner of the last-mentioned section; thence by the following sections—viz., Nos. 3 and 2, Block XII., Weber Survey District; Sections Nos. 2 and 1, Block XI., Weber Survey District; Section No. 1, Block X., Weber Survey District; and Section No. 1, Block II., of Weber Survey District—to the Dannevirke-Weber Road; thence by that road to the Mangatoro Stream; thence by that stream to the Manawatu River: thence again towards the south-east generally by the right bank of the Manawatu River to the Oruakaretake Stream: thence again towards the south-west by that stream to its confluence with the Mangapu-

kakakahu Stream ; and thence by the said Mangapukakakahu Stream to the south-western boundary-line of the Tamaki No. 4 Block ; and thence by the south-western boundary-line of said Tamaki No. 4 Block to the summit of the Ruahine Range : thence towards the north-west by the summit of the Ruahine Range to the Hawke's Bay Electoral District aforesaid.

PAHIATUA.

This district is bounded towards the north and north-east generally by the Waipawa Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the summit of the Ruahine Range to the sea at Arataura : thence towards the south-east by the sea to a point about a mile and three-quarters north of the Whakataki River, being the north-eastern corner of the Whakataki Native Reserve : thence towards the south-west generally by the said Whakataki Native Reserve to the Tinui River ; thence by the right bank of the Tinui River to Section No. 236, Block I., Castlepoint Survey District ; thence by that section, and the western boundary-lines of Sections Nos. 471, 472, and 473 of the said Block I., and the western boundary-lines of Sections Nos. 474, 475, 476, and 477, Block XIII., Aohanga Survey District, to the Pakowhai Stream ; thence by the left bank of that stream to the north-eastern corner of Section No. 42 ; thence by Sections Nos. 42 and 817 to the road intersecting the northern boundary-line of Section No. 818 ; thence by that road and its continuation through the said Section No. 817, across and along the left bank of the Makoura Stream, through Section No. 221, Block XII., Puketoi Survey District, to Section No. 222 ; thence by the said Section No. 222 and Sections No. 70 and 66 of the said Block XII., and Sections Nos. 71 and 67 of Block VIII., Puketoi Survey District, to the Waihoki Road ; thence by that road passing Burling's Homestead to Section No. 48, Block VII., Puketoi Survey District ; thence by the said Section No. 48 and Sections Nos. 20, 50, and 23 of the said Block VII. to the Puketoi Road ; thence by that road to Section No. 2, Block III., Puketoi Survey District ; thence by the said Section No. 2 and Sections Nos. 19, 20, 21, and 24 to the Kuware Road ; thence by that road to the stock-road along the top of the Puketoi Range ; thence by that road to Section No. 10, Block II., Puketoi Survey District ; thence by the said Section No. 10 and Sections Nos. 15 (E.R.) and 7 of the said Block II. to the Pori Road ; thence by the said Pori Road to Section No. 12, Block V., Puketoi Survey District ; thence by the said Section No. 12 and Section No. 13 to the road forming the south-western boundary of Section No. 6 ; thence by the south side of that road, and by Section No. 61, Block VIII., Mangaone Survey District, and Section No. 175 of the said Block VIII., to the Pa Valley Road ; thence by the said Pa Valley Road to its junction with the Mangaone Valley Road ; thence by part of Section No. 12, Block IV., Mangaone Survey District, to the Mangaone River ; thence by that river to a point in line with the north-eastern boundary-line of Section No. 31A of the said Block IV. ; thence by a right line to the easternmost corner of the said Section No. 31A ; thence by that section and Sections Nos. 31, 29, 9, 8, 7, and 6, Block III., Mangaone Survey District ; thence by Sections Nos. 25, 20A, and 20, Block II., Mangaone Survey District, to the Makakahi River ; thence by a right line across the Makakahi River to the easternmost corner of Section No. 96, Block XIV., Mangahao Survey District ; thence by the said Section No. 96 to the main road, Masterton to Pahiatua ; thence by a right line across that road to the easternmost corner of Section No. 97 ; thence by that section and Sections Nos. 100, 111, and 81 of the said Block XIV. to Central Road ; thence by the said Central Road to Section No. 77, Block XIII., Mangahao Survey District ; thence by the said Section No. 77 to the Mangahao River ; thence by a right line across that river to the easternmost corner of Section No. 10 of the said Block XIII. ; thence by that section and Sections Nos. 9, 8, 13, and 21 to the northernmost corner of the last-mentioned section ; thence by a right line through the Forest Reserve to Arawaru Trig. Station : and thence towards the north-west by the summit of the Tararua Range and the leading spur to the Manawatu River at the Gorge ; thence by a line across that river to the spur leading to the Ruahine Range ; and thence by that spur and the summit of the Ruahine Range to the Waipawa Electoral District aforesaid.

MASTERTON.

This district is bounded towards the north-east generally by the Pahiatua Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the summit of the Tararua Range to the north-eastern corner of the Whakataki Native Reserve on the east coast : thence towards the south-east by the sea to the Whareama River : thence towards the south-west generally by the said Whareama River to the confluence of the Mangapokia River with the said Whareama River ; thence by the said Mangapokia River to Section No. 240, Block III., Rewa Survey District ; thence by the said Section No. 240, and Sections Nos. 260, 261, 739, 620, 619, and 618, all of the said Rewa Survey District, to the Mangapakeha Stream ; thence by that stream and by Sections Nos. 617, 522, 521, and 520, to the southern boundary-line of Section No. 518, Block XIII., Mangapakeha Survey District, and by Section No. 524 of the said Rewa Survey District ; thence by Section No. 523, Block IV., Otahoua Survey District, the south-western boundary-line of Section No. 866 of the said Mangapakeha Survey District, and the southern boundary-lines of Sections Nos. 98 and 97, Kopuaranga Survey District ; thence by Sections Nos. 92 and 96, Block IV., Otahoua Survey District, to the Taueru River ; thence by the right bank of the said Taueru River to the Teroterowetu Creek ; thence by that creek to the Bideford Road : thence again towards the south-east by that road as far as the Wangaehu River ; thence by the said Wangaehu River to its confluence with the Ruamahanga River ; thence by the said Ruamahanga River to its confluence with the Waingawa River : thence again towards the south-west by the said Waingawa River to its source ; thence by a line due west to the summit of the Tararua Range : and thence towards the north-west by the summit of the Tararua Range and the Manawatu Electoral District, hereinafter described, to the Pahiatua Electoral District aforesaid, the place of commencement.

WAIRARAPA.

This district is bounded towards the north-east and north generally by the Masterton Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the summit of the Tararua Range to the Whareama River on the east coast; thence towards the south-east and south-west by the sea to Cape Turakirae; and thence towards the north-west by the summit of the Rimutaka Range and the summit of the Tararua Range to the Masterton Electoral District aforesaid, the place of commencement.

EGMONT.

This district is bounded towards the north and north-east by the Waikato Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the sea-coast at the south-western boundary-line of the Moeatoa Block near Tirua Point to the mouth of the Waihora Stream in Lake Taupo: thence towards the south-east by the western shore of Lake Taupo to the mouth of the Tokaanu Stream; thence by a right line to the summit of Tongariro Mountain: thence towards the south-west by a right line to the eastern corner of the Kirikau Block; thence by the north-western boundary of that block to the Wanganui River: thence again towards the south-east by the Wanganui River to the 39th parallel of south latitude: thence towards the south by the said 39th parallel of south latitude to the line known as the confiscation line: thence again towards the south-east generally by the confiscation line to the Te Wera Road; thence by the said Te Wera Road and by the road intersecting Section No. 13 (N.R.) of Block V., Ngatimaru Survey District, to the Waitara River; thence by the road along the right bank of the Waitara River to the Section No. 18 of Block V., Ngatimaru Survey District; thence by the said Section No. 18 and Sections Nos. 13, 9, and 7 of Block VIII., Huiroa Survey District, to the Makino Stream; thence by the right bank of the said Makino Stream to the north-western corner of Section No. 14 of Block XI. of the said Huiroa Survey District; thence by the said Section No. 14, and by Sections Nos. 25, 26, 27, 3, 15, 13, and 12 of Block XV. of Huiroa Survey District aforesaid, and by Sections Nos. 40 and 38 of Block XIV. of Huiroa Survey District aforesaid, to the south-western corner of the last-mentioned section, and by the western boundary-line of the said Section No. 38 produced across a road to Section No. 105 of Block II., Ngaire Survey District; thence by the said Section No. 105, and by Section No. 106 (E.R.), and by Subdivisions Nos. 6, 5, and 1 of Native Reserve, all of the said Block II., to the Borough of Stratford; thence by the Borough of Stratford (as the said borough is described in the *New Zealand Gazette* No. 57, 28th July, 1898), to Opunake Road; thence by Opunake Road to the road forming the western boundary of Section No. 57 (E.R.) of Block I., Ngaire Survey District: thence towards the west by the said road and by the road forming the western boundaries of Sections Nos. 56, 55, 54, and 53A of the said Block I. to the Patea River: thence towards the south-west by the Patea River to its source; thence by a right line to the summit of Mount Egmont: thence towards the north-west generally by a right line to the source of the Waiwakaiho; thence by the Waiwakaiho to Section No. 164 (E.R.), Hua and Waiwakaiho; thence by that section and Section No. 5 to the Mangaoraka Stream; thence by that stream to Section No. 142, Tarurutangi, Egmont Survey District; thence by the said Section No. 142 and Sections Nos. 144, 145, 146, and 147, Tarurutangi, to the Waiongona; thence by that stream to the Wanganui-New Plymouth Railway-line; thence by the western side of that railway-line to the north-western boundary-line of Section No. 204, Huirangi: thence again towards the south-east by the said Section No. 204, and again towards the south-west by the western boundary-lines of Sections Nos. 203, 202, 201, 200, 199, 198, 197, 196, 195, 194, 193, 192, 191, and 190, Tarurutangi, all of Paritutu Survey District, and by the western boundary-lines of Sections Nos. 21, 20, 19, 18, 17, 16, 15, 14, 4, 3, 2, 1, 86, 85, and 81, Huirangi, Paritutu Survey District, and by the western boundary-lines of Sections Nos. 78, 77, 73, 68, 66, 67, and 134, Waitara West, Paritutu Survey District, to the sea: and thence again towards the north and west generally by the sea to the south-western boundary-line of the Moeatoa Block, near Tirua Point aforesaid, the place of commencement.

TARANAKI.

This district is bounded towards the north-east and south-east generally by the Egmont Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the sea at the south-western boundary-line of Section No. 134, Waitara West, to the summit of Mount Egmont: thence towards the south-west by a right line to the easternmost corner of Section No. 3 of Block XI., Cape Survey District; thence by the said Section No. 3, and by Subdivisions Nos. 10, 11, and 12 of Section 6 of Block X., Cape Survey District, to Carrington Road: thence towards the east by Carrington Road to Newall Road; thence by a line across Newall Road to the north-western corner of Section No. 7 (school-site) of Block XIV., Cape Survey District; thence by the said Section No. 7 and by Sections Nos. 8, 13, 18, and 23 of the said Block XIV. to the south-western corner of the last-mentioned section: thence towards the north by Sections Nos. 23, 24, 25, 26, and 27 of the said Block XIV., and by Section No. 5 of Block XV., Cape Survey District, to the Forest Road: thence again towards the east by the Forest Road to Ngariki Road: thence towards the south by Ngariki Road to the Main South Road: thence again towards the east by the Main South Road to its junction with Manihi Road: thence again towards the south by the said Manihi Road to the sea-coast: and thence towards the west and north-west by the sea to Section No. 134, Waitara West, the place of commencement.

HAWERA.

This district is bounded towards the north-west generally and towards the north-east by the Taranaki Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the sea-coast at Manihi Road to the summit of Mount Egmont: thence towards the east by a right line to the north-western corner of Section No. 12 of Block VI., Kaupokonui Survey District; thence by

Sections Nos. 12, 14, 17, and 2 of Block VI., Kaipokonui Survey District: thence towards the north generally by Sections Nos. 2 and 3 of the said Block VI., by Sections Nos. 12, 13, 14, 15, 18, 37, 36, and 35 of Block VII., Kaipokonui Survey District, and by Sections Nos. 25, 26, 27, and Subdivision 2 of Section No. 21 of Block VIII., Kaipokonui Survey District, to Finnerty Road; thence by Finnerty Road to the Waingongoro River: thence again towards the north-east generally by the said Waingongoro River to its confluence with the Mangawhero Stream; thence by the said Mangawhero Stream to Section No. 22 of Block X., Ngaire Survey District; thence by the said Section No. 22 and by Section No. 47 of the said Block X. to the south-western corner of the last-mentioned section; thence by Section No. 19 of Block XIV., Ngaire Survey District, to Rotokare Road; thence by the said Rotokare Road to its junction with Tiromoana Road; thence by the eastern side of the said Tiromoana Road to Section No. 1 of Block III., Hawera Survey District; thence by the said Section No. 1 to the Ararata Stream; thence by the said Ararata Stream to the Whareroa Road; thence by the said Whareroa Road to its junction with the Morea Road; thence by the said Morea Road to its junction with the Mataimaroke Road; thence by the said Mataimaroke Road to its junction with the Kaitoke Road; thence by the said Kaitoke Road to its junction with the Meremere Road; thence by the said Meremere Road to its junction with Noonan Road; thence by the road forming the eastern boundary of Section No. 532 of Block XIV, Hawera Survey District, and that road continued in a southerly direction to the Manawapou River; thence by the said Manawapou River to the sea: and thence towards the south-west by the sea to the Taranaki Electoral District aforesaid at Manihi Road, the place of commencement.

PATEA.

This district is bounded towards the south-west generally by the Hawera Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the sea at the mouth of the Manawapou River to Mount Egmont: thence towards the north-west generally and towards the north by the Egmont Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to the Wanganui River: thence towards the east generally by the Wanganui River to the confluence of the said Wanganui River with the Tangarakau River; thence by a right line to the easternmost corner of the Mangaotuku Block; thence by the summit of the main range leading to Maungaru Trig. Station, Taurakawa Survey District; thence by the summit of the range leading to Mataimoana Trig. Station, Momohaki Survey District; thence by the track leading westerly to Watershed Road at the south-eastern boundary of Section No. 19 of Block IV., Momohaki Survey District; thence by the said Watershed Road to a point due west of Paparangiara Trig. Station in Block XVI., Momohaki Survey District; thence by the summit of the main range between the Manganui-o-tahu Stream and the Kauarapaoa Stream, and between the Mangamingi Stream and the Kai Iwi Stream, to Pakiri Trig. Station; thence by the summit of the Rangitatau Range to Aramaire Trig. Station No. 9 on the Ruahine Range: thence towards the east by the Hawke's Bay and Waipawa Electoral Districts, respectively hereinbefore described, to a point due east of the south-easternmost source of the Kawhatau River: thence towards the south-east generally by a line due west to the said south-easternmost source of the Kawhatau River; thence by the said Kawhatau River to its confluence with the Rangitikei River; thence by the said Rangitikei River to the south-western boundary-line of the Taraketi Block: thence towards the south-west by the south-western boundary-line of the said block to its westernmost corner; thence by the Township of Leeds, and by Blocks Nos. XXXA., CCLXXIX., CCLXXVIII., CCLXXVII., CCLXXX., CCLXXXV., CCLXXXIV., CCLXXII., CCVI., CCVII., CCLXII., CCLXIII., CCLXIV., CCXLVII., and CCXLIX., all of Wangaehu Survey District, and by the north-eastern boundary-line of the last-mentioned block produced to the right bank of the Turakina River; thence by the right bank of the said Turakina River to the northern boundary-line of the Mangatipona East Block; thence by the said Mangatipona East Block and by the Mangatipona West Block to the Wangaehu River: thence again towards the south-east by the Wangaehu River to the sea: thence towards the south-west by the sea to the southernmost corner of Run No. 15, Ikitara Survey District, near Wilson's Bluff: thence again towards the west generally by the said Run No. 15 to Section No. 258; thence by Sections Nos. 258, 257, 263, and 7 of Block IX., Ikitara Survey District, to No. 1 Line; thence by No. 1 Line to the road forming the western boundary of Section No. 104, Block VI., Ikitara Survey District; thence northerly by the last-mentioned road and its continuation, passing Sections Nos. 104, 105, 106, 107, 40, and intersecting Section No. 55 of the said Block VI.; thence by the southern boundary-line of Section No. 74, and the western boundary-lines of Sections No. 74, 75, and 73, to No. 3 Line; thence by the north side of No. 3 Line to the western boundary-line of Section No. 272, Block II., Ikitara Survey District; thence by the western and northern boundary-lines of Section No. 272 to Section No. 206; thence by the western boundary-line of Section No. 206 to Section No. 293; thence by the southern and western boundary-lines of Section No. 293, and by the southern, western, and northern boundary-lines of

Section No. 359, and by the western boundary-line of Section No. 354, to Kukuta Stream: thence again towards the south-west generally by that stream to the Wanganui River: thence by a line due west across the Wanganui River to the right bank thereof; thence by the right bank of the Wanganui River to the Mission Line of road; thence by the said Mission Line to its junction with the New Missionary Line; thence by the said New Missionary Line to its junction with the Brunswick Line; thence by the Brunswick Line to its junction with the Great Western Line: thence again towards the south-east by the Great Western Line to its junction with the Great North-western Road; thence by the south side of the Great North-western Road to the northernmost corner of Section No. 84 of Block II., Westmere Survey District; thence by the said Section No. 84, and by Section No. 234 of Block V., Westmere Survey District, to the south-western corner of the said Section No. 234; thence by a right line to a point on the coast-line about one mile and a quarter north of the flagstaff at the mouth of the Wanganui River, measured along the coast-line: and thence again towards the south-west by the sea to the Patea Electoral District aforesaid at the mouth of the Waitotara River, the place of commencement.

WANGANUI.

This district is bounded towards the west, north, and east by the Rangitikei Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from a point on the sea-coast about one mile and a quarter north of the flagstaff at the mouth of the Wanganui River to the southernmost corner of Run No. 15, near Wilson's Bluff, on the sea-coast; and towards the south-west by the sea to the place of commencement.

OROUA.

This district is bounded towards the north-west and north by the Rangitikei Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the southernmost corner of the Taraketi Block, on the right bank of the Rangitikei River, to a point on the Ruahine Range due east of the south-easternmost source of the Kawhatau River: thence towards the south-east by the Waipawa Electoral District and the Pahiatua Electoral District, respectively hereinbefore described, to the Manawatu River at the Gorge: thence towards the south-west generally by the channel of the Manawatu River south of the island in the said river to the confluence of the said Manawatu River with the Pohangina River; thence by the right bank of the Pohangina River to the road forming the northern boundary of Section No. 464, Gorge Survey District; thence by that road to the road forming the north-eastern boundary of Section No. 465; thence by the western side of the last-mentioned road to Section No. 35, Gorge Survey District; thence by the said Section No. 35 and by Section No. 79 to the road forming the southern boundary of the said Section No. 79; thence by that road and its continuation in an easterly direction to the road leading north from Ashhurst; thence by the said road leading north from Ashhurst to Spur Road, at the western boundary of Section No. 8 of Block I., Gorge Survey District; thence by Spur Road to its junction with Penelope Road; thence by Penelope Road to its junction with the Feilding Road; thence by the Feilding Road to Section No. 19, Block IV., Kairanga Survey District; thence by the said Section No. 19 to Section No. 15: thence again towards the south-west generally by the said Section No. 15, and Sections Nos. 70, 47, 46, 45, 44, 43, 42, 41, 40, 39, 38, 37, 36, 35, 34, 33, and 32, Block III., Kairanga Survey District; thence by the railway-line to and over the Oroua River, and on to Section No. 149 (Native reserve); thence by that section, Section No. 86, Block XIV., Oroua Survey District, and that portion of Sections Nos. 85 and 132 of the said Block XIV. lying to the west of a line bearing $354^{\circ} 11'$ magnetic from a point on the northern boundary-line of the said Section No. 86, distant 796 links from Awahuri Road; thence by a road and Section No. 130 of the said Block XIV. to Mount Taylor; thence by the said Section No. 130 and Sections Nos. 129 and 125, Block XIV., Oroua Survey District, Sections Nos. 124, 119, 118, and 112, Block IX., Oroua Survey District, and Section No. 111, Block XII., Rangitoto Survey District, to Mount Biggs; thence by Section No. 101, the southern boundary-line of Section No. 144 (Native reserve), and the eastern and southern boundary-lines of Section No. 99, Block XII., Rangitoto Survey District, and the said southern boundary-line produced to the right bank of Rangitikei River: and thence towards the west by the right bank of the said Rangitikei River to a point in line with the south-western boundary-line of the Taraketi Block; and thence by a right line across the Rangitikei River to the southernmost corner of that block at the Rangitikei Electoral District aforesaid, the place of commencement.

PALMERSTON.

This district is bounded towards the north-east generally by the Oroua Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the railway-bridge over the Oroua River to the Manawatu Gorge; thence towards the south-east by the Pahiatua Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to Arawaru Trig. Station on the Tararua Range; thence towards the south-west by the south-western boundary-line of the block formerly known as the Township of Fitzherbert Block (part of the north-eastern boundary-line of Horowhenua County) to the Manawatu River; thence towards the south generally by the said Manawatu River to its confluence with the Oroua River; and thence towards the west by the said Oroua River to the railway-bridge over the Oroua River aforesaid, the place of commencement.

MANAWATU.

This district is bounded towards the north, west, and north-east by the Rangitikei Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the mouth of the Wangaehu River to the southernmost corner of the Taraketi Block, Ongo Survey District: thence towards the east generally by the Oroua Electoral District and the Palmerston Electoral District, respectively hereinbefore described, to Arawaru Trig. Station on the Tararua Range: thence towards the south-east by the summit of the Tararua Range over Mairakau Trig. Station to Te Paki Trig. Station; thence by the leading

ridge through Sections Nos. 1, 2, and 3 of Block IV., Waiopahu Survey District, to the south-western boundary-line of the last-mentioned section: thence towards the south-west generally by the south-western boundary-line of the said Section No. 3 to the south-western corner of that section; thence by the west side of the road forming the western boundary of Section No. 3 aforesaid to Section No. 7 of Block III., Waiopahu Survey District; thence by the said Section No. 7 and by Section No. 6 of the said Block III. to the road at the north-western corner of that section; thence by the west side of the last-mentioned road and its continuation northerly, passing Sections Nos. 13, 10, and 6 of Block XV., Mount Robinson Survey District, to the northern boundary-line of Section No. 7 of the said Block XV.; thence by the south-western boundary-lines of Sections Nos. 4, 3, 2, and 1 of Block XV. aforesaid, and by the south-western boundary-lines of Section No. 3 of Block X., Mount Robinson Survey District, and by the north-western boundary-lines of Sections Nos. 2 and 1 of the said Block X., to the northernmost corner of the last-mentioned section at the Manawatu River; thence by the said Manawatu River to the sea: and thence towards the west by the sea to the mouth of the Wangaehu River aforesaid, the place of commencement.

OTAKI.

and Orangi-Kaupapa, to the junction of Boundary Road and Grant Road; thence along the southern side of Boundary Road to Tinakori Road; thence across the Tinakori Road to the eastern side thereof; thence along the eastern side of Tinakori Road and Karori Road to the western boundary of the Botanical Gardens Reserve; thence to the north-western corner of Section No. 28 (Upland Farm), Karori District; thence along the northern boundary of said Section No. 28 (Upland Farm) to the boundary of the City Reserves in the Terrace District: thence southerly along the western boundaries of the reserves in the said district to the south-eastern corner of the said Section No. 28 (Upland Farm): thence westerly along the southern boundary of the said Section No. 28 to the north-western corner of Section No. 11 of the City Reserves: thence southerly along the western boundary of the City Reserves: thence easterly along the northern boundary-line of Section No. 11, Ohiro, in Block X., Port Nicholson Survey District, to Ohiro Road; thence across Ohiro Road and along the eastern side of Ohiro Road aforesaid to the southern boundary-line of City Reserve No. 41: thence easterly along the southern boundary of that reserve to its south-eastern corner: thence southerly along the western boundary of City Reserve No. 38 to the City Reserve No. 37 at the north-west corner of the said Reserve No. 37: thence easterly along the northern boundary-line of the said Town Acre No. 37 to Town Acre No. 685: thence northerly along the western boundary-line of the said Town Acre No. 685 to the eastern side of Bidwell Street; thence along the eastern side of Bidwell Street to Wallace Street: thence northerly along the western side of Wallace Street to Hankey Street: thence easterly along the southern side of Hankey Street and the southern boundary-line of the Mount Cook Reserve to Town Acre No. 717: thence southerly along the western boundary-line of the said Town Acre No. 717 and along the western boundary-lines of Town Acres Nos. 718 and 719, 720, and 721 to Town Acre No. 722, Oxford Road: thence easterly along the northern boundary of Town Acre No. 722 and along the south side of Oxford Road to Tasman Street: thence southerly along the eastern side of Tasman Street and the eastern side of Crawford Street to the southern boundary of Reserve No. 11: thence easterly along that boundary to Oliver Street, and thence along the north side of Oliver Street to the junction of Adelaide Road with Revans Street: thence southerly along the eastern side of Revans Street to the northern boundary-line of Town Acre No. 762: thence easterly along the northern boundary-line of the said Town Acre No. 762, and southerly along the north-eastern boundaries of Town Acres Nos. 763, 764, 765, and 766 to the northern boundary-line of Town Acre No. 769: thence easterly generally along the northern boundary-line of Town Acre No. 769 (Hospital Reserve boundary), across Daniell Street, along the northern boundary-line of Town Acre No. 770, near the Old Men's Home, across Owen Street, to the western boundary-line of Town Acre No. 771; thence along the western and north-western boundary-lines of Town Acre No. 771 and along the north-western boundary-lines of Town Acres Nos. 772 and 773 to Coromandel Street; thence across Coromandel Street to the western boundary-line of Town Acre No. 774; thence along the western and north-western boundary-lines of Town Acre No. 774 to the northernmost corner of the last-mentioned town acre; thence along the north-eastern boundary-lines of Town Acres Nos. 774 and 775 to Mein Street; and thence along the northern side of Mein Street to the eastern boundary of the City of Wellington, at the Township of Kilbirnie: thence northerly along the western boundary-line of the said Township of Kilbirnie to the north-western corner of the said township: thence westerly along the southern boundary of Section No. 3 (Jenkins Estate): thence northerly along the western boundary-line of the said Section No. 3, and along the western boundary-line of Section No. 2 (Jenkins Estate) to the western side of Harbour View Road, in the Township of Roseneath: and thence northerly along the western side of the said Harbour View Road and that side of the said road produced to Lambton Harbour: thence westerly and northerly along the shore of Lambton Harbour to the eastern boundary of the land granted to the Corporation of the City of Wellington on the 24th June, 1874; thence along the said eastern boundary and along the seaward boundary of the said land to the eastern boundary of the land granted to the Superintendent of Wellington on the 18th October, 1855; and thence along the seaward boundary of the last-mentioned land and the seaward boundary of the reclaimed land to the place of commencement: including Somes Island.

NEWTOWN.

This district is bounded towards the west and north generally by the Otaki Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the mouth of the Karori Stream to the north-western corner of Upland Farm, Karori District: thence towards the north-east and towards the north-west generally by the City of Wellington Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to a point in line with the western side of Harbour View Road in the Township of Roseneath; thence by Lambton Harbour to Point Jerningham: thence again towards the south-east and south-west by Evans Bay to Port Halswell: thence towards the east by the water of Port Nicholson to Palmer Head: and thence towards the south and west by the sea to the mouth of the Karori Stream aforesaid.

Stations A and V to Mount Riley: thence again towards the south-east by the summit of the main range between the Wakamarina River and the Wairau River, over Mount Sunday and Mount Baldy to the summit of the main range between the Pelorus and Wairau Valleys; thence by the summit of that range, over Fishtail and Mount Richmond and Old Man, to the boundary-line between the Land Districts of Nelson and Marlborough: thence again towards the south-west and north-west by the boundary-line between the Land Districts of Nelson and Marlborough to the southern boundary-line of Square 18: thence again towards the south by a line running due west until it is intersected by a right line bearing S. 45° W. from a point about two miles distant from the north-eastern corner of Section No. xviii., Suburban North, and in line with the north-eastern boundary-line of the said Section No. xviii.: thence again towards the south-east by a right line bearing S. 45° W., until it intersects the River Lee: thence towards the south-west generally by the said River Lee to its confluence with the River Roding; thence by the latter river to its confluence with the River Wairoa, and thence by the last-mentioned river to the Nelson-Belgrove Railway-line; thence by the said railway-line to the south-western boundary of Section No. 40 of Block IX., Waimea Survey District; thence by the south-western boundary-line of the said Section No. 40 and that line produced across the Wai-iti River to Section No. 1 of 161; thence by the southern boundary-line of Part of Section 1 of 161 of the said Waimea Survey District, by the south-western boundary-line of Section No. 165, and the north-western boundary-line of the said Section No. 165, and part of the north-western boundary-line of Section No. 162, to the southern corner of Section No. 16, Waimea Survey District; thence by the south-western and north-western boundaries of the said Section No. 16 and the north-eastern boundary of Section No. 17 to the westernmost corner of Section No. 12, Waimea Survey District; thence by the north-western boundary-line of the said Section No. 12 to the road which forms the northern boundary of that section; thence by that road and its continuation, passing Sections Nos. 13, 14, 26, 19, 206, 182, and 4, Wai-iti Survey District, to the westernmost corner of Section No. 186, Eve's Valley, of the said Wai-iti Survey District; thence by the north-western boundary of the said Section No. 186 to Section No. 37, Wai-iti Survey District; thence by Sections Nos. 1, 188, 7, and 27 to the southernmost corner of Section No. 126, Wai-iti Survey District; thence by the south-western boundary-lines of Sections Nos. 126 and 127 to the westernmost corner of the last-mentioned section; thence by Sections Nos. 29, 19, 3, 4, 11, 157, 13, 16, 14, 151, and 15, all of Wai-iti Survey District: thence towards the west generally by Sections Nos. 13, 11, 111, 10, 6, 5, and 4, Block XIV., Motueka Survey District, and by Section No. 1, Block XV., Motueka Survey District: thence towards the north generally by Sections Nos. 21 and 73, Block XI., Motueka Survey District, and by Sections Nos. 74, 138, 141, 143, 145, 84, 82, and 81, Block XV., Motueka Survey District, and by Sections Nos. 80, 115, 1, 158, 159, 26A, 27, and 31A, Block XVI., Motueka Survey District, to the south-eastern corner of the last-mentioned section; thence by Sections Nos. 29 and 28, 1 and 2, Moutere Survey District, to the southernmost point of the last-mentioned section; thence by a right line to the western extremity of Rabbit Island, the place of commencement: including D'Urville Island, Stephen's Island, Rabbit Island, Saxon's Island, Oyster Island, Pepin Island, and Fifeshire Island.

MOTUEKA.

THIS district is bounded towards the north-west and north by the sea from the Ngakawhau River to the Cape Farewell Lighthouse: thence towards the east generally by Golden Bay and Tasman Bay to the City of Nelson Electoral District, hereinbefore described, at Rabbit Island: thence towards the south generally and towards the north-east by the said City of Nelson Electoral District to the summit of the watershed between the Wairau and Pelorus Valleys: thence towards the south-east generally by the boundary-line between the Land Districts of Nelson and Marlborough to Tophouse; thence by the summit of St. Arnaud Range and the summit of the Spenser Mountains to Faerie Queen: thence towards the south-west generally by the summit of the leading range to the Cann Range, and thence by the summit of the Cann Range to the saddle between the Rivers Warwick and Warbeck; thence by the summit of the leading ridge to the Mantell Range, and thence by the summit of the Mantell Range and by the leading spur to the Buller River at a point about 30 chains to the westward of the confluence of Doughboy Creek with the Buller River: thence again towards the south by the right bank of the Buller River to the western boundary-line of Inangahua County: thence towards the west by the said western boundary of the Inangahua County to Bald Hill, Block X., Lyell Survey District, on the Lyell Range: thence again towards the south-west by the summit of the watershed leading up to the head-waters of Lyell Creek and Slaty Creek and by the summit of the leading spur to the source of the said Slaty Creek: thence by a line due west to the nearest source of the Ngakawhau River; and thence by the said Ngakawhau River to the sea.

BULLER.

This district is bounded towards the north-east generally by the Motueka Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the mouth of the Ngakawhau River, on the west coast, to Faerie Queen, on the summit of the Spenser Mountains: thence towards the south-east by the summit of the Spenser Mountains to the watershed between the Grey and Maruia Rivers: thence towards the south-west generally by the summit of that watershed to Mount Haast; thence by the summit of the western watershed of the Inangahua River over Trig. Stations G, P, O, and A, Waitahu Survey District, to the source of the Devil's Creek; thence by the watershed between Devil's Creek and Slab Hut Creek and the watershed between the Inangahua River and the Mawhera-iti River to the source of the said Mawhera-iti River; and thence by the leading spur to the summit of the main range leading to Mount Faraday; thence by the summit of that range to Mount Faraday: thence again towards the south-east by the summit of the Paparoa Mountains to a point due east of the source of the Pororari River: thence again towards the south-west by a right line to the source of the Pororari River, and by the Pororari River aforesaid to the sea: and thence towards the west and north-west by the ocean to the mouth of the Ngakawhau River aforesaid, the place of commencement.

GREY.

This district is bounded towards the north-east generally by the Buller Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the mouth of the Pororari River, on the west coast, to the watershed near the source of the Grey River: thence towards the south-east by the summit of the main range leading to the saddle between the north branch of the Hurunui River and the Taramakau River: thence towards the south-west by a right line to where the Arnold River debouches from Lake Brunner: thence again towards the south-east by Lake Brunner to the mouth of the eastern Hohonu River: thence again towards the south-west generally by that river to a point due east of the confluence of Foley's Creek with Blackwater Creek: thence by a right line in the direction of the confluence of the said creeks to the summit of the range leading northerly to the source of the Eight-mile Creek; thence by the summit of that range and by Eight-mile Creek to the New River; thence by the New River to Maori Creek Road; thence by that road to the A.K. Road; thence by the last-mentioned road to Card's Creek, and by Card's Creek to a bend in that creek about 50 chains east of Section No. 2027, Waimea Survey District; thence by a right line to the confluence of Hughes's Creek with the Taramakau River, and thence by the said Taramakau River to the sea: and thence towards the west by the sea to the mouth of the Pororari River aforesaid, the place of commencement.

WESTLAND.

This district is bounded towards the north and north-east generally by the Grey Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the mouth of the Taramakau River, on the west coast, to the saddle between the north branch of the Hurunui River and the Taramakau River; thence towards the south-east by the summit of the Southern Alps to Mount Aspiring; thence towards the south-west by a right line to the mouth of the Awarua River in Big Bay; and thence towards the north-west by the ocean to the Grey Electoral District aforesaid, the place of commencement.

WAIRAU.

This district is bounded towards the north-west generally by the Motueka Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from Tophouse to the summit of the watershed between the Wairau and Pelorus Valleys, and by the City of Nelson Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to the entrance to Pelorus Sound: thence towards the east generally and towards the south-east by Cook Strait and the sea to the Ure River: thence towards the south by the Ure River to its source, near Big Cregan, on the Kaikoura Range; thence by a right line to Big Cregan on the Kaikoura Range; thence again towards the south-east by the summit of the Kaikoura Range over Tapuaenuka and Mount Monro to Barefell Pass: and thence towards the south-west by a right line to Tophouse aforesaid: including Arapawa, The Brothers, and adjacent islands.

HURUNUI.

This district is bounded towards the north-east and north-west generally by the Wairau Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from Tophouse to the mouth of the Ure River at the sea-coast: thence towards the south-east by the sea to the Ashley River: thence towards the south and west by the said Ashley River to its source; thence by the summit of the range leading to Esk Head Peak: thence again towards the south-west by the summit of the range leading over the Candlesticks to the source of the south branch of the Hurunui River; thence by a right line to the saddle between the north branch of the Hurunui River and the Taramakau River: thence again towards the north-west by the Grey Electoral District, hereinbefore described, the Buller Electoral District, hereinbefore described, and the Motueka Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to the Wairau Electoral District aforesaid at Tophouse, the place of commencement.

KAIAPOI.

This district is bounded towards the north by the Hurunui Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from a point on the left bank of the Ashley River in line with a right line joining Trig. Station 16, Mairaki Survey District, and the north-western corner of Section No. 9791 of the said Mairaki Survey District, to the mouth of the Ashley River: thence towards the east by Pegasus Bay to the mouth of the Waimakariri River: thence towards the south generally by the right bank of the said Waimakariri River to the confluence of the north branch of that river with the south branch thereof; thence again by the right bank of the Waimakariri River aforesaid to a point due south of the easternmost extremity of Section No. 11253 (island in the Waimakariri

River): thence towards the west by a right line to the easternmost extremity of the said Section No. 11253, and by that line produced to the left bank of the Waimakariri River: thence again towards the south by the left bank of the Waimakariri River to a point due north of the western extremity of Section No. 7845 (part of Baile's Island): thence again towards the east by a right line to the western extremity of Section No. 7845 aforesaid: thence towards the north-east by the southern boundary of Baile's Island to a point in line with the eastern side of Fleshborn Road, in Block V., Christchurch Survey District: thence again towards the east by a right line in the direction of the eastern side of Fleshborn Road aforesaid to the right bank of the Waimakariri River: thence again towards the south generally by the right bank of the Waimakariri River to a line being the production of the western side of the road forming the south-eastern boundary of Section No. 32083 of Block IV., Hawkins Survey District: thence towards the north-west by a right line to the southernmost corner of that section; thence by the said Section No. 32083 to its easternmost corner; thence by a right line to Trig. Station 48, in Block XIII., Mairaki Survey District: thence towards the north-east by the road running south-easterly from the said Trig. Station 48 to its intersection by the north-western boundary-line of Section No. 33451, Block XIII., Mairaki Survey District, produced: thence again towards the north-west by a right line to the westernmost corner of the said Section No. 33451, and thence by the western boundary-line of Section No. 33451 aforesaid and by the western boundary-lines of Sections Nos. 33342, 30310, and 34754 of Block IX., Mairaki Survey District, to the north-western corner of the last-mentioned section; thence by a right line to the south-western corner of Section No. 15260 of Block IX., Mairaki Survey District aforesaid; thence by the western boundary-line of the said Section No. 15260 and the western boundary-lines of Sections Nos. 13681 and 13682 of Block IX., Mairaki Survey District, to the north-western corner of the said Section No. 13682; thence by a right line across the River Eyre to the south-eastern corner of Section No. 18588 of Block IX., Mairaki Survey District; thence by the said Section No. 18588 to its north-eastern corner; thence by a right line to the southernmost corner of Section No. 23164 of Block IX., Mairaki Survey District aforesaid; thence by the said Section No. 23164 and by Sections Nos. 19574, 23243, and 4643, Mairaki Survey District, to the north-eastern corner of the last-mentioned section; thence by a right line across the Oxford and Rangiora Railway-line to the south-eastern corner of Section No. 13633, Mairaki Survey District; thence by the road which forms the eastern boundary-line of the last-mentioned section, and by that road continued passing Sections Nos. 20562, 20912, 17980, 17265, 13678, 12782, 12783, and 10678, Mairaki Survey District, to the easternmost corner of the last-mentioned section; thence by a right line to the north-western corner of Section No. 9791, Mairaki Survey District; and thence by a right line drawn in the direction of Trig. Station 16 to the left bank of the Ashley River aforesaid, the place of commencement.

This district is bounded towards the north-west and north generally by the Kaiapoi Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the southern boundary-line of Baile's Island in the Waimakariri River at a point in line with the eastern side of Fleshborn Road, Block V., Christchurch Survey District, to the mouth of the Waimakariri River: thence towards the east by Pegasus Bay to a point in line with the northern side of the road which forms the north-eastern boundary of Reserve No. 2638, Christchurch Survey District: thence towards the south-west by a right line to the northern side of the said road, and thence by the said road and its continuation in a north-westerly direction, passing Sections Nos. 2340, 31684, 20428, and 20429, to the road forming the north-western boundary of Sections Nos. 20278 and 20279, Christchurch Survey District: thence again towards the north-west by the last-mentioned road to Purarekanui Creek: thence towards the south-east by the Purarekanui Creek to its confluence with the Styx River; thence by the Styx River to the south-western boundary-line of Rural Section No. 294 of Block VII., Christchurch Survey District; thence by the said Section No. 294 to Hawkins Road: thence towards the east by Hawkins Road to its junction with Hill's Road; thence by Hill's Road to its junction with Kelly's Road: thence towards the south by Kelly's Road to Shirley's Road: thence towards the north-east by Shirley's Road to the Borough of St. Albans: thence again towards the south-east and towards the north-east respectively by the Borough of St. Albans (as the said Borough of St. Albans is described in the *New Zealand Gazette* No. 102, 24th November, 1881) to the River Avon at the road forming the south-western boundary of original Rural Section No. 6, Christchurch Survey District: thence against towards the south-east by the River Avon to the western boundary-line of Hagley Park: thence again towards the east and towards the south by the western and southern boundary-lines of Hagley Park to the Lower Lincoln Road: thence again towards the south-east by the Lower Lincoln Road to Junction Road: thence towards the south-west by Junction Road to Middle Lincoln Road: thence again towards the south-east by Middle Lincoln Road to the road forming the north-western boundary of Rural Section No. 327, Block XIV., Christchurch Survey District; thence by that road, the road forming the northern and western boundaries of Rural Section No. 2176, and by the road forming the western boundary of Rural Section No. 550 to Halswell Junction Road: thence again towards the south-west by Halswell Junction Road to the Southbridge Railway-line: thence again towards the north-west by the Southbridge Railway-line to the Main South Road; thence by the Main South Road to Hornsby Junction Road, and thence by Hornsby Junction Road to and across the Dunedin-Christchurch Railway-line to Yaldhurst Road: thence again towards the south-west by Yaldhurst Road to Kaiapoi Junction Road: and thence again towards the north-west by Kaiapoi Junction Road to Coringa Road: thence again towards the south-west by Coringa Road to the road intersecting Section No. 6113 of Block V., Christchurch Survey District: thence again towards the north-west by the last-mentioned road and its continuation in a north-easterly direction through a reserve to Fleshborn Road; thence by Fleshborn Road and by the eastern side of Fleshborn Road produced to the right bank of the Waimakariri River at the Kaiapoi Electoral District, the place of commencement.

AVON.

This district is bounded towards the north-west and the north by the Riccarton Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the Borough of St. Albans to Pegasus Bay: thence towards the east by Pegasus Bay to the estuary of the Heathcote and the Avon Rivers: thence towards the south-west and towards the south-east by the said estuary to the south-western side of the Canal Reserve: thence again towards the south-west by the south-western side of the said Canal Reserve (being the north-eastern boundary of the Borough of Woolston) to a point in line with the south-eastern side of Aldwin's Road: thence again towards the south-east by a right line to the south-eastern side of Aldwin's Road, and by the south-eastern side of that road and its production to the southern side of Ferry Road: thence again towards the south-west by the southern side of Ferry Road to Ensor's Road: thence again towards the south-east by the eastern side of Ensor's Road to the reserve for the Christchurch-Lyttelton Railway: thence again towards the south-west by that reserve to Wilson's Road on the Sydenham Borough boundary: thence again towards the north-west by Wilson's Road to Ferry Road: thence again towards the south-west by Ferry Road to the East Town Belt of the City of Christchurch: thence again towards the west by the said East Town Belt to the River Avon; thence by the production of the eastern side of the East Town Belt across the River Avon to the left bank of that river: thence again towards the north and north-west by the left bank of that river to a point in line with the southern boundary-line of a subdivision of Section No. 197, Block XI., Christchurch Survey District, containing 3 acres and 35 perches: thence towards the south by a right line to the said southern boundary-line; thence by that boundary-line to the road which forms the north-western boundary of a subdivision of the said Section No. 197, containing 5 acres 2 roods; thence by that road to a road intersecting the said Section No. 197, and by the last-mentioned road to the North Avon Road; thence by that road to Hill's Road: and thence towards the west by the said Hill's Road to Shirley's Road, and by Shirley's Road to the Riccarton Electoral District aforesaid, the place of commencement.

CITY OF CHRISTCHURCH.

LYTTELTON.

This district is bounded towards the north-east and north generally by the City of Christchurch Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from Selwyn Street, to where Wilson's Road is crossed by the Christchurch-Lyttelton Railway: thence towards the north-west and the north-east generally by the Avon Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to the estuary of the Heathcote and Avon Rivers; thence by the said estuary and by Pegasus Bay to Godley Head: thence towards the south and east by Lyttelton Harbour to the head of the bay at the bridge near the mouth of the Te Rapu Stream; thence by a line to the nearest point of the road which forms the eastern boundary of Section No. 25401 of Block VII., Halswell Survey District; thence by that road and its continuation towards Gebbie's Pass, passing Sections Nos. 344, 481, 75, 13920, 34609, and 35602, to Section No. 21471 of Block XI., Halswell Survey District: thence again towards the south by the said Section No. 21471 and Section No. 6076 to the road which forms part of the southern boundary of Section No. 35602 of the said Block XI.; thence by the south side of that road and its continuation westerly, passing Sections Nos. 6260, 4190, and 1383, to the western boundary-line of Section No. 1194; thence by that section and Section No. 4621 of the said Block XI. to Section No. 1390: thence towards the west generally by the said Section No. 1390, and Sections Nos. 1196, 14334, 33951, 1182, 1060, 906, 34555, 13609, 34551, 18809, 1443, 35510, 1403, 33748, and 565 of Block VII., Halswell Survey District, and by Sections Nos. 485, 33742, 521, 520, 491, 338, and 493, all of Block III., Halswell Survey District, to the road intersecting the last-mentioned section; thence by that road and its continuation northerly, intersecting the said Section No. 493 and Section No. 10210, and passing along the western boundaries of Sections Nos. 2231, 31363, 31362, 2063, and 1325 to the Hoon Hay Road; thence by the Hoon Hay Road to the plantation and road reserve separating Sections Nos. 382 and 383 of Block XV., Christchurch Survey District; thence by the north site of the said plantation and road reserve to the Heathcote River; thence by the Heathcote River to Barrington Road: thence towards the south-west by Barrington Road to Stark's Road: and thence again towards the north-west by Stark's Road to its junction with Selwyn Street: and thence again towards the south-west by Selwyn Street to the boundary of the City of Christchurch Electoral District aforesaid, the place of commencement.

ELLESMERE.

COURTENAY.

This district is bounded towards the north generally by the Kaiapoi Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from a point on the right bank of the Waimakariri River in line with the south-eastern boundary-line of Section No. 32083 of Block IV., Hawkins Survey District, to the Riccarton Electoral District, hereinbefore described, at Fleshborn Road: thence towards the east and towards the north-west generally by the Riccarton Electoral District to the City of Christchurch Electoral District, hereinbefore described, at Lincoln Road; thence by the said City of Christchurch Electoral District to Selwyn Street: thence towards the east by the Lyttelton Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to the south-western corner of Section No. 28012 of Block VII., Halswell Survey District: thence towards the south by the Ellesmere Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to the River Selwyn: thence towards the south-west by the River Selwyn to the Wakaepu Branch thereof; thence by the said Wakaepu Branch to the road forming the north-western boundary of Section No. 24284 of Block IX., Hawkins Survey District: thence again towards the north-west by that road and its continuation in a north-easterly direction to the northernmost corner of Section No. 1524 of Block V., Hawkins Survey District; thence by a right line to the southernmost corner of Section No. 14156 of Block II., Hawkins Survey District; thence by the said Section No. 14156 and by Sections Nos. 19530, 19529, 26161, 18640, and 18421, and by the eastern boundary-line of the last-mentioned section produced to the Waimakariri River: and thence towards the north-east by the Waimakariri River to a point in line with the south-eastern boundary-line of Section No. 32083 of Block IV., Hawkins Survey District, at the boundary of the Kaiapoi Electoral District aforesaid, the place of commencement.

Stream, in the Rakaia River; thence by that river to its source; and thence by a line due west to the Southern Alps at the Westland Electoral District, hereinbefore described; and thence again towards the north-west by the Westland Electoral District aforesaid to the Hurunui Saddle, the place of commencement.

This district is bounded towards the north and north-east generally by the Ashburton Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the eastern boundary of Run No. 77, near Two-thumb Range, to the ocean at the mouth of the Rangitata River: thence towards the south-east by the ocean to the mouth of the Ophi River: thence towards the south by the right bank of the Ophi River to the north-western boundary-line of Section No. 21122, Block IV., Pareora Survey District: thence again towards the south-east generally by that section and Section No. 10454, Block IV., and Sections Nos. 12448, 16677, and 17800, Block VIII., Pareora Survey District, to the Albury Railway-line; thence by that railway-line to the road forming the south-eastern boundary of Section No. 15245, Block VIII., Pareora Survey District; thence by that road and its continuation, passing Sections Nos. 12242, 13744, 12875, 13516, 15830, 15877, 17304, and 19165, Block VIII., Pareora Survey District, to the road at the south-eastern boundary of Section No. 17311; thence by the road which forms the south-eastern boundaries of Rural Sections Nos. 15906, 20737, 33002, 15876, 18976, 19510, 19077, 19298, 20661, 21223, 17575, 15829, and 22135, all of Pareora Survey District, to the Cliffs Road; thence by a right line to the south-eastern corner of Section No. 30253, Pareora Survey District; thence by a road at the south-eastern corner of the said Section No. 30253; thence by the said road and its continuation westerly to the road at the western boundary of Section No. 19891; thence by that road in a northerly direction, passing Sections Nos. 28531 and 24741, Pareora Survey District, to Section No. 30248 at the Tengawai River; thence by a right line across the said Tengawai River to the south-eastern corner of Section No. 5394, Pareora Survey District; thence by the Tengawai River aforesaid to the Main Mackenzie Road at the south-western corner of Section No. 27, Albury Settlement, Block XV., Tengawai Survey District; thence by the said Main Mackenzie Road to the north-western boundary-line of Section No. 28941; thence by the north-western boundary-line of the said Section No. 28941 and of Section No. 27460, Tengawai Survey District, to the Ophi River: thence again towards the south-west by the left bank of that river to Section No. 30438, Block III., Tengawai Survey District: thence again towards the north-west by the said Section No. 30438 and Sections Nos. 30437, 30454, 19949, 20209, and 25368 to the South Opuha River: thence again towards the south-west by the South Opuha River to its source in Two-thumb Range: thence again towards the north-west by the summit of Two-thumb Range to the source of Forest Creek: again towards the north generally by the said Forest Creek to the Ashburton Electoral District aforesaid.

TIMARU.

This district is bounded towards the north-west and towards the north generally by the Geraldine Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the road at the north-western corner of Section No. 19891 of Block IX., Pareora Survey District, to the mouth of the Ophi River; thence towards the south-east by the sea to the mouth of the Pareora River; and thence towards the south-west by the Pareora River to where that river is intersected by the road being the continuation of the road forming the north-eastern boundary of Section No. 33288 of Block XI., Pareora Survey District; thence northerly by that road and its continuation to the north-western corner of Section No. 19891 aforesaid, at the Geraldine Electoral District aforesaid, the place of commencement.

OAMARU.

This district is bounded towards the north by the Waitaki Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from a point in line with the western boundary-line of Section No. 92 of Block I., Awamoko Survey District, to the sea at the mouth of the Waitaki River: thence towards the south-east by the sea to the mouth of the Kakanui River: thence towards the south generally by the

WAIKOUAITI.

Station F, Maungatua Survey District; thence towards the north by a right line to the said Trig. Station F; thence again towards the west by a line drawn due north to Lee's Stream; thence again towards the south-west by Lee's Stream to its source; and thence towards the south generally by the summit of the watershed between the Waipori River and Deep Stream to Lammerlaw Range aforesaid, at the Mount Ida Electoral District aforesaid, the place of commencement.

BRUCE.

TUAPEKA.

This district is bounded towards the north-east by the Mount Ida Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the Dunstan Mountains to Lammerlaw Range at the Taieri Electoral District: thence again towards the north-east and towards the east generally by the Taieri Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to the Waipori River: thence towards the south-east generally by the Bruce Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to the confluence of Crook Burn with the Clutha River: thence towards the south-west by the Clutha River to the confluence of Blackcleugh Burn with the said Clutha River; thence by Blackcleugh Burn to a point due south of Tapanui Hill; thence by a right line to the said Tapanui Hill; thence by the summit of the range to Trig. Station L, Crookston Survey District: thence again towards the south-east by the south-eastern boundary-lines of Blocks XIV. and XI., Crookston Survey District: thence towards the south by the southern boundary-line of the said Block XI. to its south-western corner; thence by Sections Nos. 1, 12, 30, 32, and 37, Block III., Crookston Survey District, and Sections Nos. 20, 9, 11, 12, 29, and 13, Block IV., Greenvale Survey District, and Sections Nos. 2, 7, 12,

CLUTHA.

This district is bounded towards the north and east generally by the Tuapeka Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from Leithen Burn to the confluence of the Crook Burn with the Clutha River: thence towards the north-east generally by the Bruce Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to the ocean: thence towards the south-east by the ocean to the Waipati Estuary near Chasland's Mistake: thence towards the south-west generally by the Waipati Estuary and by the Waipati River to a point due east of Black Horn; thence by a right line to Black Horn; thence by a line due north to the northern boundary-line of Section No. 1 of Block XIV., Waikawa Survey District: thence again towards the south by the said Section No. 1 to its north-western corner: thence again towards the west by Section No. 5 of Block XIV., Mokoreta Survey District: thence again towards the south by the said Section No. 5 and by Section No. 3 of the said Block XIV. to its northernmost corner: thence again towards the west by a right line to Trig. Station EE; thence by the summit of the watershed over Bleak Hill, the Chimney and Flower Pot to Catlin's Cone; thence by a right line to the source of the Waipahi River in Section 1, Block XI., Kuriwao Survey District; thence by the said Waipahi River to a point due east of the north-eastern corner of Section No. 6 (P.R.), Block VI., Slopedown Survey District: thence towards the south by a right line to the said north-eastern corner; thence by the said Section No. 6 and Run No. 162 (education endowment) to the northern boundary-line of Block VII., Slopedown Survey District; thence by the said Block VII. and Blocks VIII. and IX., Slopedown Survey District, to Block X., Tuturau Survey District; thence towards the west by the said Block X. and Blocks IX. and VIII., Tuturau Survey District, and by a right line from the north-eastern corner of the last-mentioned block to the south-western corner of Block IX., Waikaka Survey District; thence by the western boundary-lines of Blocks IX., VI., and III., Waikaka Survey District, to the northern boundary-line of the last-mentioned block: thence again towards the north by the northern boundary-line of the said Block III. to the south-eastern corner of Chatton Survey District: thence again towards the west by Chatton Survey District to the road leading to Chatton Village: thence towards the south by that road, passing Maitland Village, to Chatton Village: thence towards the north-west by the road forming the south-eastern boundary of Section No. 9, Block V., Chatton Survey District, and by that road continued in a north-easterly direction to and through Waikaka Township, and through Block XI., Greenvale Survey District, to Run No. 175B; and thence by Run No. 175B to Leithen Burn, at the boundary of the Tuapeka Electoral District aforesaid, the place of commencement.

MATAURA.

from the Pyramid Bridge to Chatton Village : thence towards the north again by that road to the road at the south-eastern corner of Section No. 9 of Block V., Chatton Survey District, on the boundary of the Clutha Electoral District aforesaid, the place of commencement.

WAKATIPU.

This district is bounded towards the north and north-west by the Westland Electoral District, hereinbefore described : towards the east by the Mount Ida Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from the Southern Alps to the Dunstan Mountains ; thence by the Tuapeka and the Clutha Electoral Districts, respectively hereinbefore described, to the road at the south-eastern corner of Section No. 9 of Block V., Chatton Survey District : thence towards the south by the Maitara Electoral District, hereinbefore described, to the northern boundary-line of Section No. 449, Hokonui Survey District : thence towards the west generally by Section No. 798 (known as Small Grazing-run No. 21), Hokonui Survey District, and by Sections Nos. 354 and 179 to Cowan's Creek ; thence by Cowan's Creek to the road intersecting Section No. 178 of Hokonui Survey District : thence towards the south-west by that road and its continuation through Section No. 91, Hokonui Survey District, to the road forming the south-eastern boundary of Sections Nos. 351 and 353 of Hokonui Survey District, and by the last-mentioned road continued to the Township of Balfour ; thence by lines so as to include the Township of Balfour to the Waimea Plains Railway ; thence by the Waimea Plains Railway to the Township of Lumsden ; thence by lines so as to include the Township of Lumsden to the Oreti River ; thence by the Oreti River to a point due west of Hummock Peak ; thence by a right line to Hummock Peak ; thence by the summit of the watershed over Mount Lookup and the Thompson Mountains to a line drawn between Round Peak and Moffat Peak : thence towards the south by a right line to Moffat Peak ; thence by a right line to Mount Eglinton : thence again towards the south-west by the summit of the Earl Mountains to a point in line with the Castle Mountain and Cloudy Pass : thence again towards the south by a right line over the said Castle Mountain and Cloudy Pass to Bligh Sound ; and thence by the said Bligh Sound to the ocean : and thence again towards the north-west by the ocean.

WALLACE.

This district is bounded towards the north-east generally by the Wakatipu Electoral District, hereinbefore described, from Bligh Sound to the northern boundary-line of Section No. 449, Hokonui Survey District ; thence by the Maitara Electoral District to the northern boundary-line of Forest Hill Hundred : thence towards the south by the northern boundary-line of Forest Hill Hundred, the northern boundary-line of Winton Hundred, and the northern boundary-line of Oreti Hundred to the road which forms the north-eastern boundary of Section No. 53, Oreti Hundred ; thence by Section No. 63 and the road which forms the south-eastern boundary of Section No. 53, and that road continued through Section No. 62 of the said Oreti Hundred to the road which forms the western boundary of the said Section No. 62 ; thence by the eastern side of that road to Section No. 108 : thence again towards the south by the said Section No. 108 and Sections Nos. 107 and 44 to the north-western corner of the last-mentioned section : thence again towards the east by the said Section No. 44 and Sections Nos. 43, 80, 86, 89, 90, 91, 94, and 95, all of the said Oreti Hundred, to the south-western corner of the last-mentioned section : thence again towards the south by the New River Hundred to the Waimatuku Stream : thence again towards the east by the left bank of that stream to the ocean : and thence again towards the south and towards the west by the ocean to Bligh Sound aforesaid, at the Wakatipu Electoral District aforesaid.

INVERCARGILL.

This district is bounded towards the north by the Waihopai River ; thence towards the east by the road forming the north-eastern boundaries of Sections Nos. 12, 17, and 16 of Block II., Invercargill Hundred (Mill Road) ; thence towards the south-east by the Invercargill-Dunedin Road to Oteramika Road ; thence again towards the north-east by the Oteramika Road and by the eastern boundary-line of the Borough of South Invercargill (as the said borough is described in the *New Zealand Gazette* No. 16, 15th February, 1883) to the Campbelltown Hundred ; thence towards the south by Campbelltown Hundred ; and towards the west by the New River Estuary to the Waihopai River aforesaid.

AWARUA.

This district is bounded towards the west and north by the Wallace Electoral District, hereinbefore described ; towards the east generally by the Maitara Electoral District, hereinbefore described ; and towards the south-west by Foveaux Straits to the Wallace Electoral District aforesaid, the place of commencement : exclusive of the Invercargill Electoral District, hereinbefore described, and including Stewart Island, Centre Island, Ruapuke Island, Dog Island, and all adjacent islands.
