Return to an Order of the House of Representatives dated the 24th July, 1903.

Ordered, "That there be laid before this House a return showing—(1) All moneys received by the Government from the sale of totara forests in the North Island from the 31st March, 1895, to the 31st March, 1903; (2) what accounts are credited with the proceeds, and the sum placed to the credit of each account; and (3) the moneys spent on roads in totara-growing districts during the above-mentioned periods."—(Mr. JENNINGS.)
