REPORT OF BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION FOR YEAR ENDED 31st MARCH, 1905.

THE Board have to report that during the year ended 31st March last two sergeants, a chief detective, and two constables were retired with annual allowances under the Act and placed on the Fund. The particulars are as follows:—
