CIVIL SERVANTS AND OTHER GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES

(TOTAL SALARIES AND WAGES PAID TO) DURING 1903-4.

Return to an Order of the House of Representatives dated the 30th June, 1904.

Ordered, "That there be laid before this House a return showing the total paid in salaries and wages during the financial year commencing the 1st April, 1903, and ending the 31st March, 1904—(a) to Civil servants; (b) to temporary clerks; and (c) to all persons, other than Civil servants, temporary clerks, and school-teachers, employed by the Crown in any capacity whatever, including persons employed in the public works."—(Mr. HERDMAN.)
