This estimate will probably not be exceeded, and in such case it will not meet the expenditure by £600. As, however, we have a cash surplus of £3,424, to which may be added the outstanding fees of the Survey and Land Titles Court, £1,043 19s. 3d., and as the suggested public works are of urgent necessity, no exception can fairly be taken to our drawing on the surplus for such works.

Schedule I discloses the receipts and expenditure on the whare manuhiri, which has now been leased to Mrs. Kohn at £40 per annum, a rate that will keep the buildings and furniture in repair. Schedule J deals with the sale of liquor under the Licensing Act of 1904, and demonstrates the sobriety of the people of these Islands so far as imported liquors are concerned. Schedules K and L explain all payments made under the contingent votes for general purposes and Land Titles Court.
