The number of indecent and sexual offences dealt with during the year under review was 451, being 99 in excess of the previous year. The majority (349) were cases of indecent exposure or behaviour. The exemplary punishment recently inflicted for outrages on girls of tender years will no doubt have a salutary effect.

DRUNKENNESS.

There has been an increase of 993 in the number of persons prosecuted for drunkenness during the year as compared with the previous year.

From the following table it will be observed that 41.39 per cent. of the males and 61.79 per cent. of the females had previous convictions recorded against them, and 7.48 per cent. of the males were not permanent residents in the Dominion.
