POLICE PROVIDENT FUND:

REPORT OF BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION FOR YEAR ENDED 31st MARCH, 1903.

Laid before Parliament in pursuance of Section 25 Subsection (5) of "The Police Provident Fund Act, 1899."

THE Board have to report that during the year ended 31st March last one sergeant and seven constables were retired with annual allowances under the Act and placed on the Fund. The particulars are as follows:—
