E D U C A T I O N : TEACHERS' SUPERANNUATION FUND.

Laid before Parliament in pursuance of the Act.

THIRD REPORT OF THE BOARD CONSTITUTED BY "THE TEACHERS' SUPERANNUATION ACT, 1905," AND "THE PUBLIC SERVICE CLASSIFICATION AND SUPERANNUATION AMENDMENT ACT (PART I), 1908."

FOR PERIOD ENDING 31ST DECEMBER, 1908.

The Honourable the Minister of Education.

SIR,—

Wellington, 20th July, 1909.

The Board has to submit the following report for the period ending 31st December, 1908.

The number of contributors to the fund on the 31st December, 1908, was 2,931, being an increase of 49 above the number on the register on the 31st March, 1908. Of this number, 2,416 were original members and 515 ordinary members—that is, persons who were first permanently employed after the date of the coming into operation of the Acts. Details are given in the following table:—

It is found on comparison of the number of *original* contributors at the 31st March, 1908, with the number as at 31st December, 1908, that, as a result of the admissions to and withdrawals from the fund during the year, there is a decrease of 43 contributors whose contributions were at the rate of 5 per cent., 14 at 6 per cent., 5 at 7 per cent., 4 at 8 per cent., 8 at 9 per cent., and 19 at 10 per cent.; while there was an increase of 1 at 5 per cent., 1 at 7 per cent., and 2 at 8 per cent., the totals showing a net *decrease* of 89 in the number of original contributors. A similar comparison of the number of *ordinary* contributors shows a decrease of 12 at 5 per cent., 2 at 6 per cent., 1 at 7 per cent., 2 at 8 per cent., and 2 at 9 per cent.; while there was an increase of 115 at 5 per cent., 19 at 6 per cent., 6 at 7 per cent., 10 at 8 per cent., 3 at 9 per cent., and 4 at 10 per cent.: a total net *increase* of 138 ordinary members. It will be observed that the decrease relates to "original" members on account of whom a greater liability is attached to the fund than in the case of ordinary members; but, as will be seen in Table I of the Appendix, a large proportion of the retiring members left the Education service before becoming entitled to other than a refund of their contributions. Details are given in the following table:—

Under the provisions of section 24 of "The Public Service Classification and Superannuation Amendment Act, 1908," every person who was a contributor to the fund in accordance with the provisions of Part IX of "The Education Act, 1908," at the date [10th October, 1908] of the passing of the first-named Act became a contributor to the fund under that Act, *unless* within six months he elected to remain subject to the provisions of the second-named Act. The statement contained in Table C shows the number of such elections.

The aggregate annual rate of salaries of the contributors to the fund on the 31st December, 1908, was £454,646, as compared with £446,607 as at the 31st March, 1908, and the annual rate of contributions increased from £32,870 to £33,057. Details are given in the following table:—

Of the number of contributors who retired during the period ending 31st December, 1908, 18 (including 9 "medically unfit" cases) were granted annual allowances aggregating £994 11s. 6d. Ten (10) widows and 12 children, the representatives of 10 contributors who died, were granted annual allowances (£341 4s.), and also a refund of the contributions (£341 4s. 7d.). The total number of retired contributors on account of whom annual allowances were granted during the period was therefore 28. One (1) contributor whose length of service was not over fifteen years retired as being "medically unfit for further duty," and was granted a sum equal to one-twelfth part of the total salary received by her during all the years of her service prior to the 1st January, 1906, together with a refund of her contributions to the fund, the amounts being £43 17s. 4d. and £6 16s. 9d. respectively: total, £50 14s. 1d. To 83 contributors who voluntarily retired from the Education service before becoming entitled to participate in the benefits of the fund contributions amounting to £1,276 5s. 4d. were returned. The total number of contributors who retired from the Education service during the period was 112.

Five (5) pensioners died during the year. Particulars as to the personal representatives in two cases have not yet been received; in a third case—a widow of an annuitant—the pension and all further liability on the fund ceased; in the other two cases there were left 2 widows, and 2 children under the age of fourteen years, to whom annual allowances were granted. One (1) child attained the age of fourteen years, and her allowance consequently ceased. Further details are given in the following statement (3):—
