## MIDWIVES PRACTISING IN THE DOMINION

(RETURNS RELATIVE TO).

Return to an Order of the House of Representatives dated the 11th November, 1909.

Ordered, "That there be laid before this House a return showing—(1) The number of midwives qualified by local examinations practising in the Dominion; (2) the number of midwives qualified by foreign examinations practising in the Dominion; (3) the number of midwives registered without examination practising in the Dominion; (4) the number of mi wives qualified by local examinations annually since passing of "The Midwives Act, 1904"; and (5) the number of midwives capable, under existing means of instruction, of being qualified by local examinations annually."—(Mr. Reed.)

- 1. Number of midwives qualified by local examinations practising in the Dominion:-

  - (a.) Trained in a maternity hospital: 93.
    (b.) Untrained women who had neglected to register when "The Midwives Act, 1904," came into force, and were allowed to do so on passing a simple practical examination: 128.
- 2. Number of midwives qualified by foreign examinations practising in the Dominion: 141.
- 3. Number of midwives registered without examination practising in the Dominion: 742.
