A yield of 40 tons of excellent sheaf oats was received and stacked in readiness for chaffing as required. About 18 tons of hay were harvested, and about 3 tons of carrots and swedes grown.

400 bushels of feed-oats were received from Eweburn Nursery.

The average number of men employed during the year was 7.66.
