TOGETHER WITH MAP SHOWING THE LOCALITY OF THE SAME.

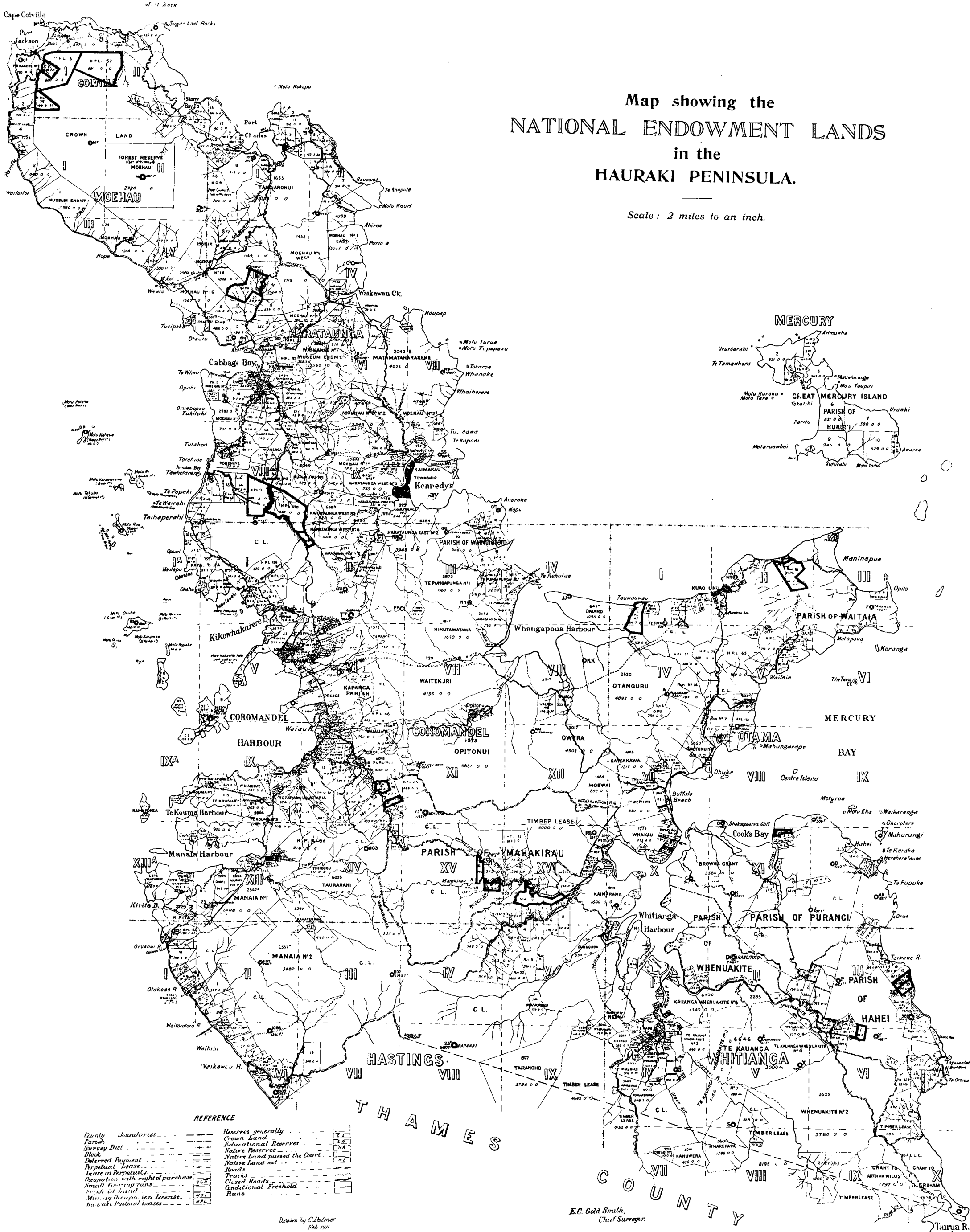
