REPORT OF THE TOURIST AGENT, ROTORUA.

. The Tourist Agent at Rotorua (Mr. William Hill) reports as follows:-

BUILDINGS AND BATHS.

During the year the buildings belonging to the Department were maintained in good order, the necessary repairs and improvements being effected. The Sanatorium has had its shingle roof removed and a new galvanized-iron roof laid and various improvements added, the chief of which was an auxiliary electric cooker to facilitate the preparation of foods required for invalids when the main (coal) range was either fully occupied or not alight.

WATER-SUPPLY.

During the year forty-seven new consumers have been connected to the mains, and, as most of them have been in the suburbs, these connections involved the laying of considerable lengths of piping.
