We have the honour to submit our report for 1914 on the work and condition of the primary schools in the Wellington District.

Statistics.—The total number of schools in active operation at the end of the year was 166, as compared with 169 in 1913; six schools having been closed—viz., Akitio, Korokoro South, Maungapakeha, Mitchelltown, Pencarrow, Weraiti, and three, Kelburn, Mangapari, and Mangaroa, having been opened. Visits of examination and inspection were paid to eighteen private schools.
