Ordered, "That there be laid before this House a return showing the amount collected from the farmers' income-tax imposed by the Finance Act, 1915; the return also to show the amount received from income-tax payers of £50 and under, and the amount received from taxpayers paying over £50 of farmers' income-tax."—(Mr. PEARCE.)
