OTHER CASUALTIES.

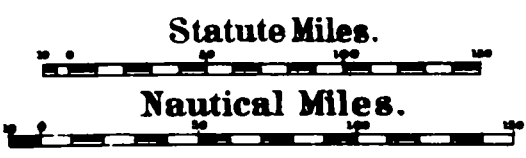
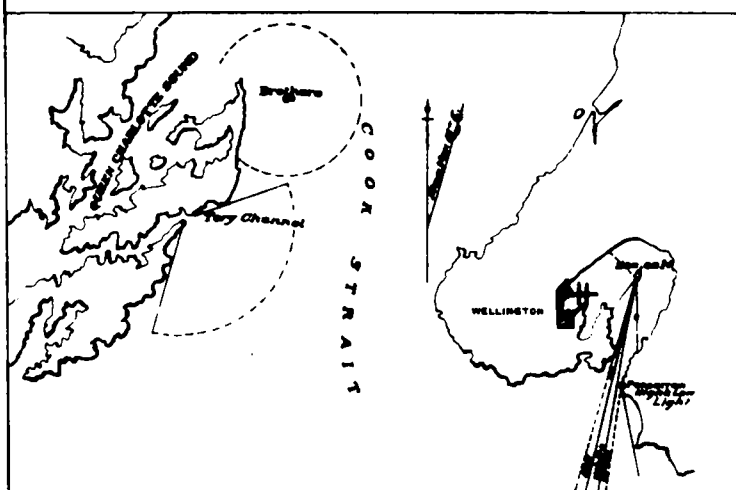
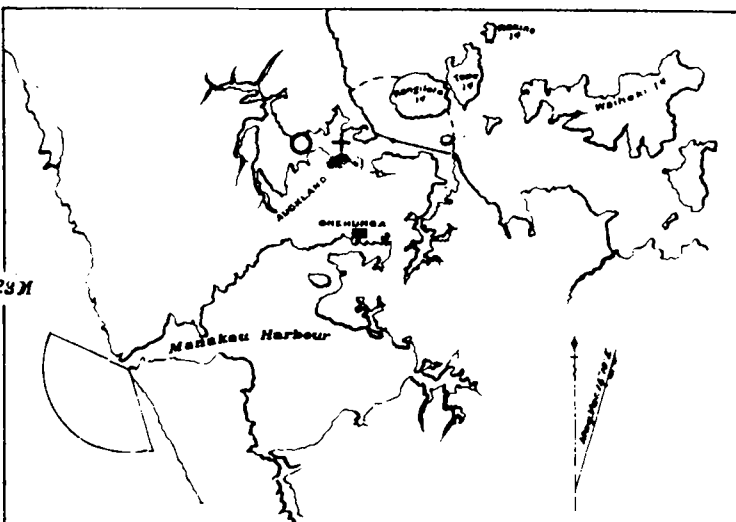
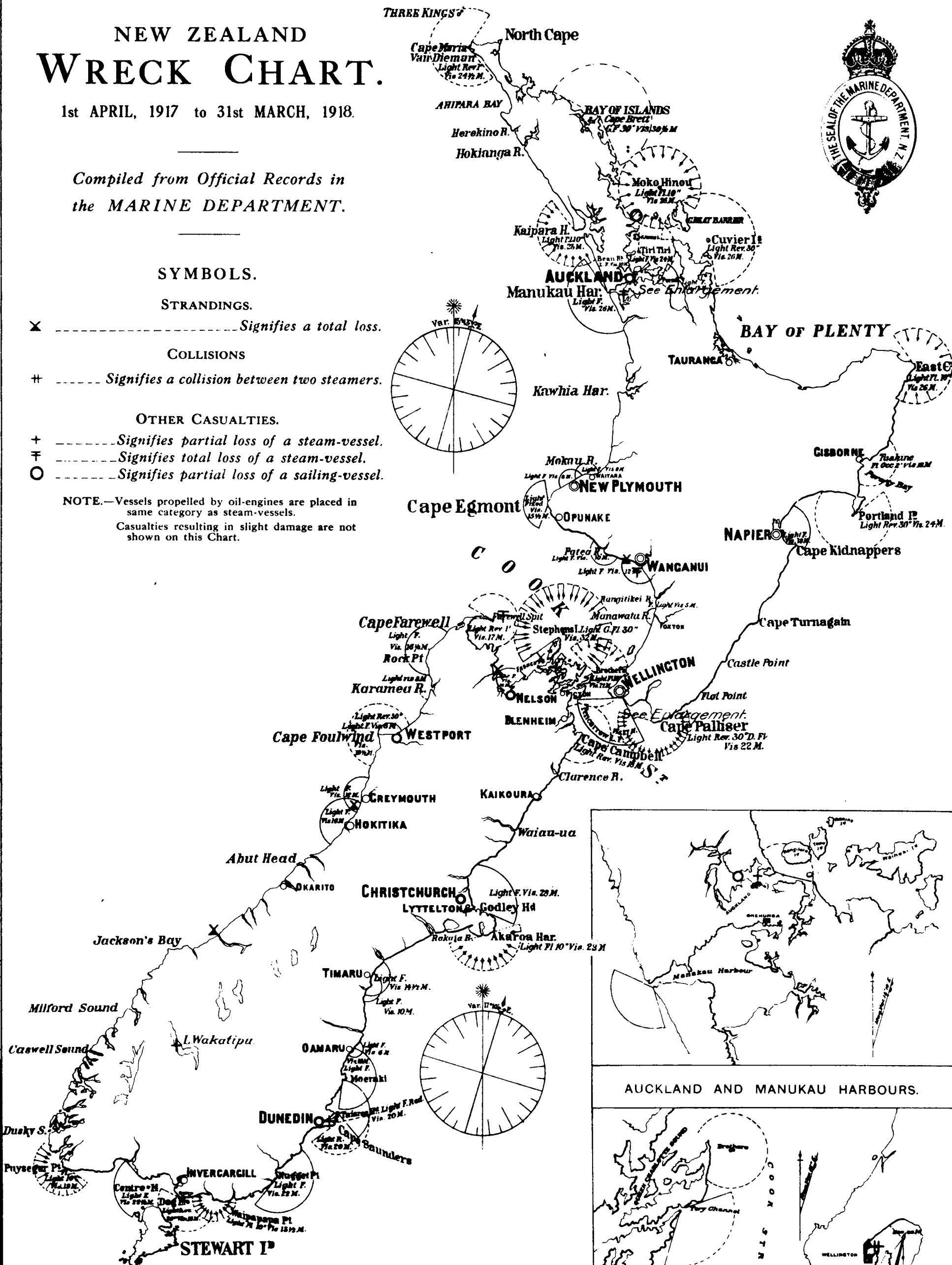
+ ----- Signifies partial loss of a steam-vessel.
