General.--Several alterations in the Superannuation Act are necessary, and the Government will be requested to introduce a Bill to Parliament at the first opportunity embodying the necessary amendments.

The Board is pleased to report that section 26 of the Appropriation Act, 1918, authorizes the increase of the amount of the annual Government subsidy to £86,000, that being the sum reported by the Actuary as required to meet liabilities falling due for each year of the triennial period 1917 to 1919, inclusive.
