The instalments owing on the 31st March show a slight increase—from £1,689 1s. 8d. last year to £1,963 4s. 5d.; but, as the number of dwellings also increased—from 688 to 825—the average per dwelling decreased from £2 9s. 1d. to £2 7s. 8d., which is an average of 8s. 3d. per dwelling per year since erection. Of the amount owing on the 31st March—viz., £1,963 4s. 5d.—the sums paid off by the 16th April were £858 15s. 2d., leaving £1,104 9s. 3d. owing at the latter date, or £1 4s. 5d., per dwelling, or an average of 4s. 3d. per dwelling per year, as against 4s. 5d. on the 16th April, 1920.
