Accommodation.--It will, in the near future, be necessary to increase the accommodation, so that more room may be obtained to enable the work to be done in the most efficient manner. It is poor economy when work which requires skill and judgment has to be carried out where light is bad and room cramped.

The new wing of the Department is ideal, and it is hoped that some time in the near future the old portion of the building will be brought more in keeping with up-to-date printing establishments, where light, space, and air are considered such valuable aids to the achievement of the best work.
