# UNEXHAUSTED LOAN AUTHORITIES

POSSESSED BY THE GOVERNMENT AS AT THE 1st DECEMBER, 1921 (RETURN OF).

*Return to an Order of the House of Representatives dated the 20th December, 1921.*
