Remarks.—The comparatively large number of recent retirements of contributors under the age of sixty-five years has thrown on the fund a heavy immediate financial burden which normally would have been postponed for many years. An increased Government subsidy will be required for the current triennium, in accordance with the Actuary's report on his examination of the fund. This report will be presented to Parliament, and the Board will, if necessary, make representations to the Government to secure payment of the additional amount required to preserve the solvency of the fund.

Recommendations have been made to the Government by the Board for certain amendments of the Superannuation Act, and it is hoped that a Bill will be introduced during the coming session to give legislative effect to the Board's proposals.
