The total funds of the societies and branches as on the 31st December, 1922, amounted to $\pounds 2,593,692$, made up as follows: Sick and Funeral Funds (inclusive of amounts transferred to special funds out of surplus), $\pounds 2,427,973$; Medical and Management Funds, goods, &c., $\pounds 165,719$. Dividing the total funds by the number of members at the end of the year it is found the average capital per member is now $\pounds 32$ 2s. 2d.
