## EXPENDITURE.

The total net expenditure under all votes and accounts appearing on the public-works estimates for the financial year ended 31st March, 1924, was  $\pounds 5,314,460$ . Of this sum  $\pounds 4,065,565$  was expended out of General Purposes Account, and the balance,  $\pounds 1,248,895$ , out of special accounts.

A brief summary of this expenditure, as well as the total expenditure since the inception of the public-works policy to the 31st March last, is shown below in tabular form :—
