I have to report that I have completed the audit of the accounts of Mangatu Block No. 1 for the year ended 31st March, 1925, also the Accounts of Mangatu No. 2, Blocks 3 and 4, for a similar period, and have pleasure in enclosing copy of same.

Farm Accounts.—An amount of £11 10s. has been debited to Mangatahu which was incurred on behalf of Pukutarewa. Further amounts of £1 10s. 5d. and 14s. 1d. incurred on account of Waitangirua have been charged against Pukutarewa. These accounts will be adjusted during the current year.

Mangatu Nos. 3 and 4.—These accounts are incorporated in the accounts of Mangatu No. 1 Block, and a separate balance-sheet and Income Account are enclosed herewith.
